VC, proctor of JU receive threats from alleged ICS men

The Vice Chancellor (VC) of Jahangirnagar University (JU) Prof Amirul Islam Chowdhury and proctor Asfar Ahmed have recently received threats over telephone and in writing from some persons reportedly belonging to Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS), administrative sources said.

The persons, introducing themselves as ICS activists, over telephone and through letters accused the VC and proctor of not helping them in their abortive bid to capture two residential halls of the University on July 1.

The alleged ICS activists threatened the VC and proctor with "action" that would make them "lame" if they continued to be unfavourable to the ICS. They also threatened the VC and proctor of dire consequences if "the JU administration continues the official preparations to oust 26 ICS activists from the University for their terrorist activities on the campus on July 1."

Savar thana police have been informed of the threats and the security of the VC and proctor have been tightened.

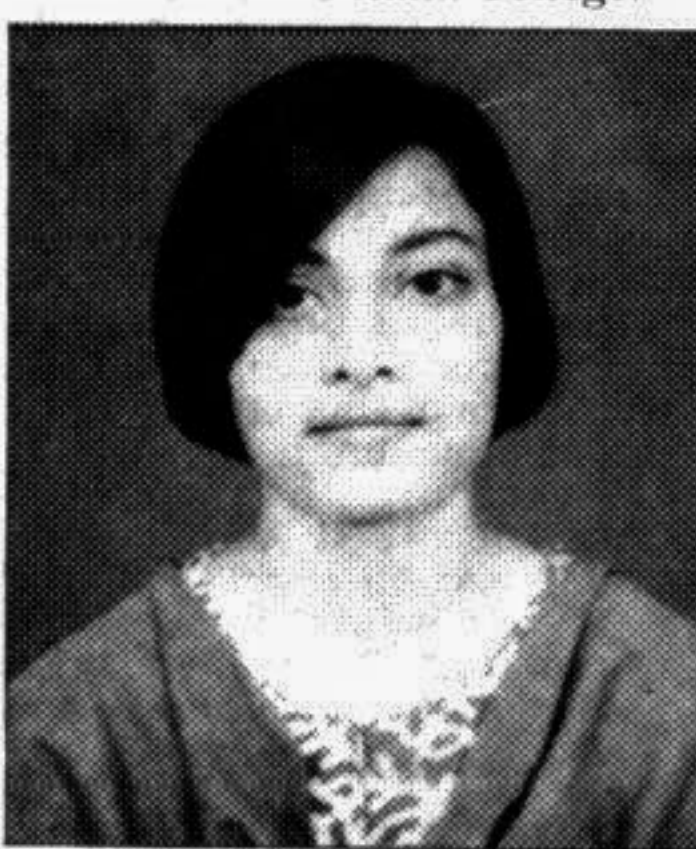
Bangladeshi student dies in US
