The United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) and the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) seek applications from Bangladeshi nationals for the position of "Project Coordinator" for joint ESCAP/UNCTAD project on Railway Wagon Information and Control System (RAILWICS) to be implemented with the support and cooperation of Bangladesh Railways (BR).

During the assignment, the Coordinator will work under the overall direction of the Director, ESCAP, Transport, Communications and Tourism Division, Bangkok, and under the substantive supervision of UNCTAD ACIS Programme Manager, Geneva.

The Coordinator will be based in Dhaka, in the Project office. He/she will work in a team of three United Nations experts, coordinate the activities at the administrative and logistics levels, and collaborate in training and organizational activities with other UN Team members.

The coordinator will be responsible for:

(a) coordinating project activities with Bangladesh Railway management; (b) coordinating activities of Project Team comprising a Team of UN Experts and a Team of Bangladesh Railway staff members associated with the Project; (c) participating in activities related to organizational aspects of traffic monitoring procedures, with UN Railway Specialist; (d) participating in the preparation and the delivery of training at all levels to Bangladesh Railway staff; (e) producing project reports on a periodic basis; (f) preparing Steering Committee meeting reports; (g) maintaining project monitoring data; (h) participate in the monitoring of the RAILWICS system performance during the later phases of the project; (i) administrative and logistics matters related to project implementation.

Salary: To be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Duration of Employment: Total involvement may be up to 20 work months, with probation period of 3 months. Up to 9 work-months within a year, commencing approximately 1 October, 1996. Total duration of the project would be 2 years.

Qualifications:

Economist or Engineer, 35-45 years old. Transport experience in Bangladesh, ideally with the railways (traffic and commercial), at mid management level. Experience with computer applications would be an asset. Experience with internationally funded project is highly desirable. Other qualification should include office management experience, good training capabilities, good reporting capabilities (in English). He/she should be fluent in English and knowledge of Bengali would be an advantage. Preference will be given to equally qualified female applicants.

Children's workshop

Fifty children from 25 organisations had a day-long workshop of their dreams and aspirations at the premises of the Women Voluntary Association (WVA) in the city yesterday.

The workshop was organised by the Bangladesh Shishu Adhikar Forum (BSAF) in collaboration with the UNICEF.

The children had discussions, sang songs and made posters about issues such as early marriage, housing in the slums, child labour for 6 to 18 hours a day, poor education facilities, inadequate food and clothing and lack of necessary water and sanitation facilities.

Various NGOs that participated in the workshop "Children's perspective in Bangladesh in their future" included UCCEP, DUS (Bangladesh), Save the Children (USA), Nari Moitree, SEEP and Phuli. Similal workshops have already been held at Rajshahi, Chittagong, Rajbari, Jessor, Khulna and two other places in the country.

At the end of the day, they came up with statements of the views of the children on their statements.

The statements will be presented at a conference of the SAARC ministers, to be held August 20-22 in Islamabad. Along with ministers, experts from seven SAARC countries are scheduled to attend the conference.

One murdered, 3 die in separate incidents in city

A young man was allegedly murdered while three persons died in separate incidents in the city Monday.

Ramna police recovered the body of the unidentified man, aged about 30, from the park near the Osmani Auditorium in Gulistan area at about 9 am. Police, who found the mark of a noose around the neck of the victim, suspect he was murdered.

An unnatural death case has been filed with Ramna police.

Meanwhile, one Matiur Rahman, 60, was killed when a speeding truck ran over him near the Alam Market at Jurine under Demra thana at about 9 am, hospital sources said.

In another road accident, an unidentified male aged about 35 was fatally injured at Pikepara under Tejgaon thana at about 2 am. He succumbed to his injuries at the DMCH in the afternoon, hospital sources said.

Besides, one Abdul Malek, 35, was electrocuted in his house at Kalachandpur under Gulshan thana at about 1:30 pm.

The bodies were sent to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.
