earned a net profit of Tk. 34,70,37,300 in 1994-95 and Tk. 26,93,44,166 in 1995-96. Prof Abu Sayeed, State Minister for Information told the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday, reports BSS.

In a written reply to a question from Nizamuddin Khan (BNP-Manikgani), the state minister said in 1994-95 Bangladesh television had earned a sum of Tk. 59,55,07,000 from advertisements and other heads while spent a sum of Tk 24,84,69,700 and in 1995-96 the figures were Tk. 56,07,77,166 and Tk. 29,14,27,000 respectively."
He also informed the House


