Two inquiry committees, one headed by the then Director of Hospitals and Clinics A B M Ahsanullah and the other headed by the then Civil Aviation Minister Abdul Mannan had investigated the alleged irregularities last year.

The Ahsanullah committee in the report, published in the November 30 1995 issue of The Daily Star had said "Due to the faulty system of the Islamia Eye Hospital (IEH), patients who under went cataract operation there developed infection which ultimately led to the removal of eyes in a number of cases."


