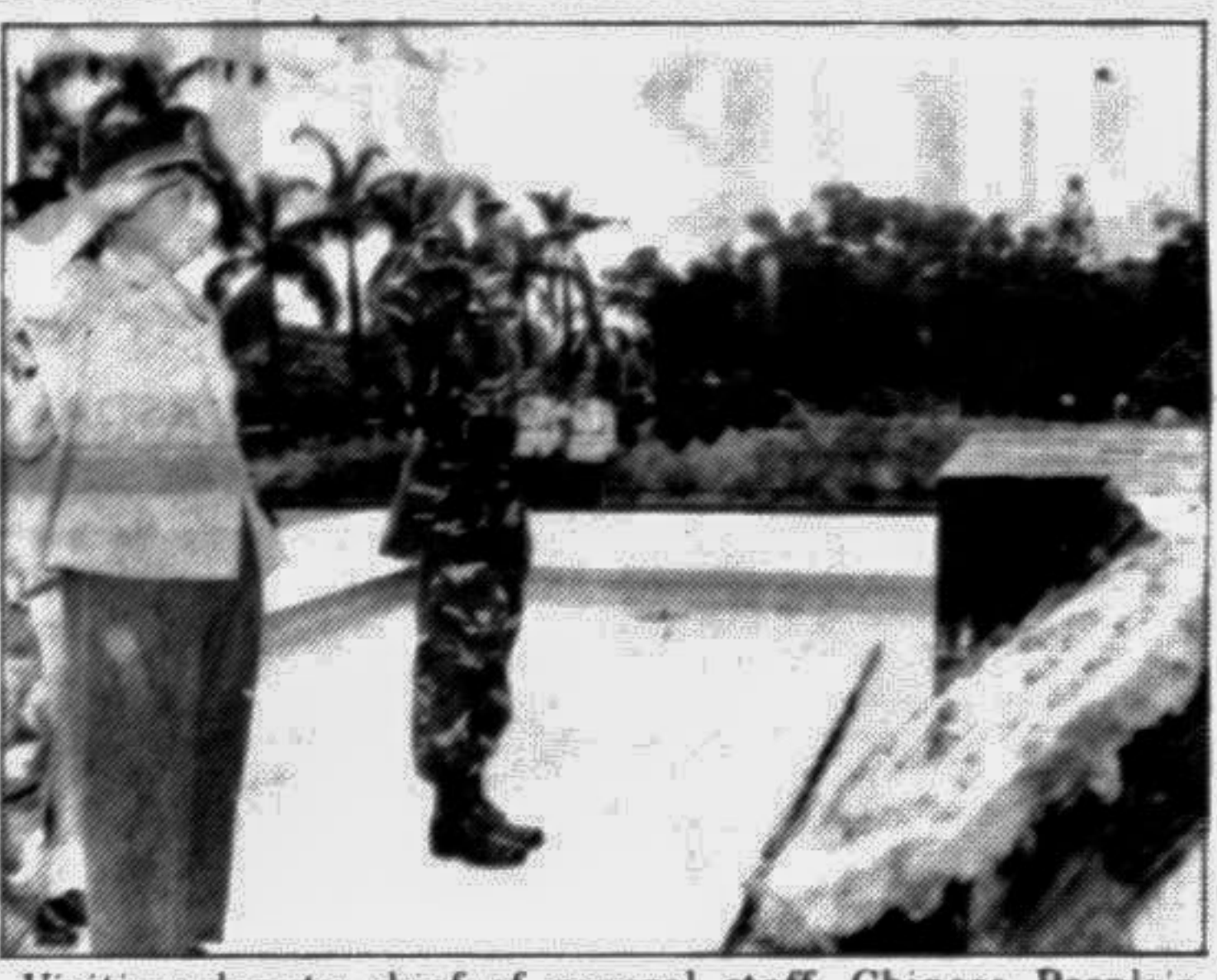

184 firearms recovered

Police recovered 184 pieces of illegal firearms and 749 rounds of ammunition from different parts of the country during the past week, beginning from August 14, after the expiry of the time limit for surrendering such arms, reports BSS.

A police press release yesterday said that 104 persons had been arrested during the same period for possessing illegal arms and explosives. Besides, 5,115 more persons had also been arrested in connection with different cases.

The press release said the Dhaka Metropolitan Police had unearthed an illegal arms manufacturing factory in the Sabujbagh police station area last week and seized arms as well as components and spare parts of arms from the factory.

Seminar on fodder crisis held

State Minister for Fisheries and Livestock Satish Chandra Roy yesterday said the government had adopted different programmes to increase livestock and overcome the fodder crisis, reports BSS.

He called upon the private sector to come forward in these fields, side by side the government initiatives.

The state minister was speaking as the chief guest at the inaugural function of a seminar, organised by the Business Advisory Service Centre (BASC), on fodder crisis and its solution.

Roy said that fodder crisis could be solved to a great extent by ensuring optimum utilisation of traditional and non-traditional raw materials for fodder. He also laid emphasis on fodder processing through improved method.

Health Minister visits IEH

Health Minister Salahuddin Yousuf visited the Islamia Eye Hospital (IEH) in the city Sunday and held a meeting with its director Dr Mustafizur Rahman.

Mentionably, there has been allegations of irregularities, mismanagement and faulty treatment of patients in the hospital for long. Eyes of some patients were removed following faulty cataract operations during August-September last year, according to press reports earlier.

Two inquiry committees, one headed by the then Director of Hospitals and Clinics A B M Ahsanullah and the other headed by the then Civil Aviation Minister Abdul Mannan had investigated the alleged irregularities last year.

The Ahsanullah committee in the report, published in the November 30 1995 issue of the Daily Star had said "Due to the faulty system of the Islamia Eye Hospital (IEH), patients who under went cataract operation there developed infection which ultimately led to the removal of eyes in a number of cases."
