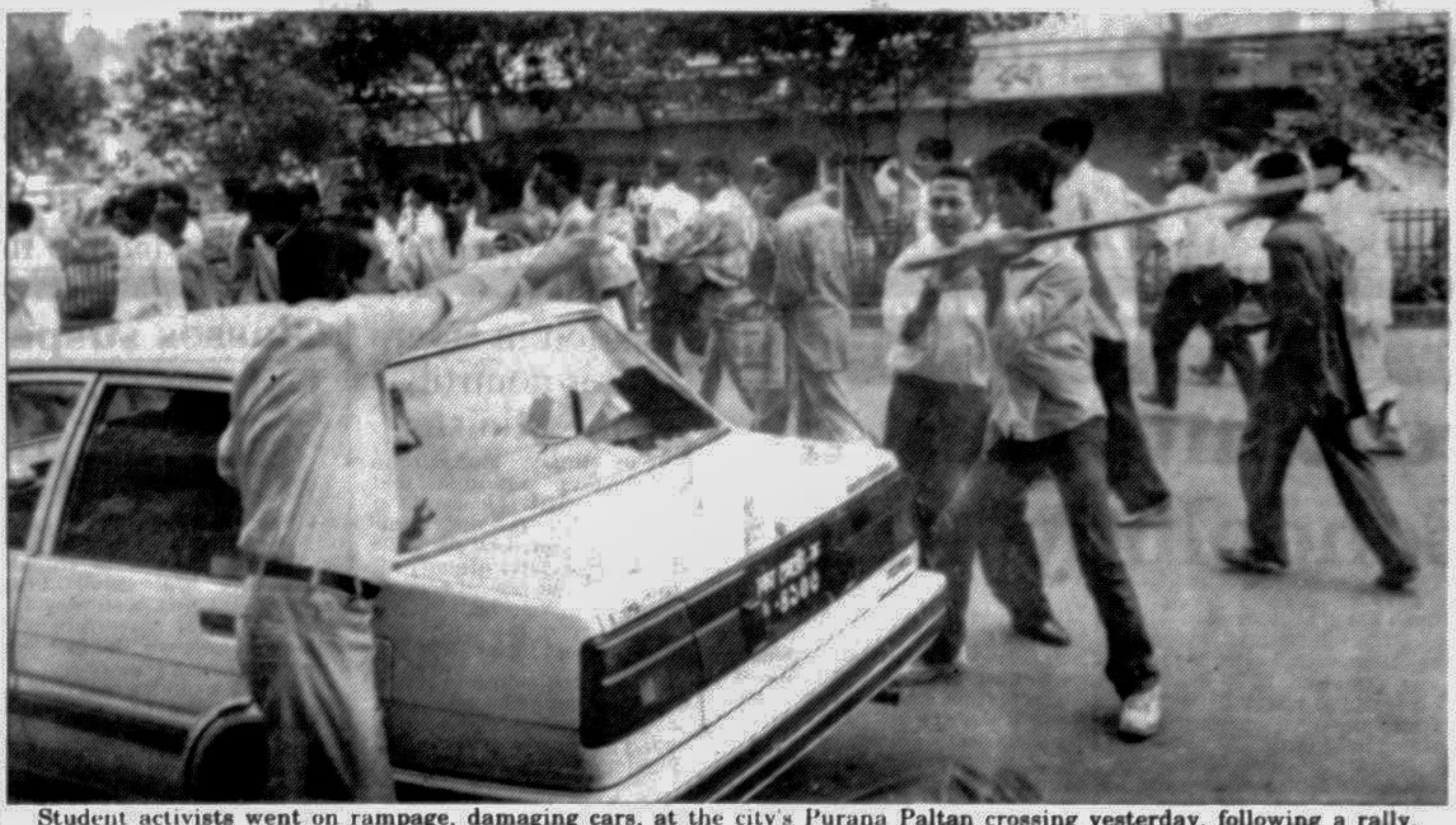

Aifa Anwar, a teacher at a New York public school and former journalist of The Daily Star, has given the voice for the computer programme.

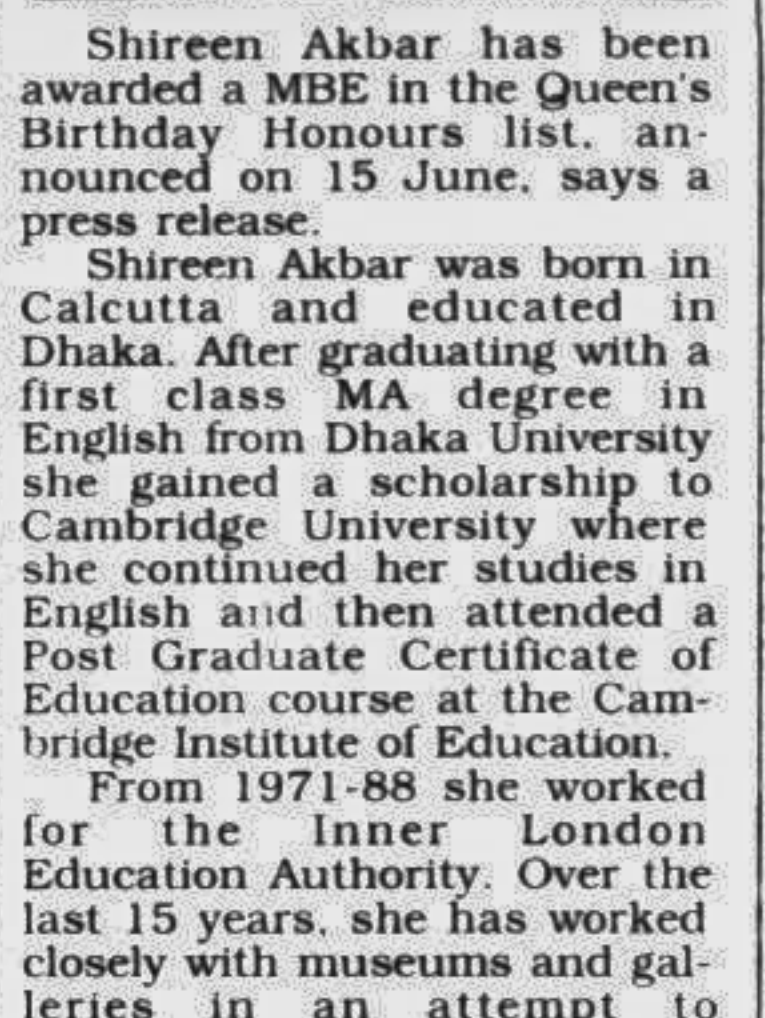
**Bangladeshi woman awarded MBE**

Shireen Akbar has been awarded a MBE in the Queen's Birthday Honours list, announced on 15 June, says a press release.

Shireen Akbar was born in Calcutta and educated in Dhaka. After graduating with a first class MA degree in English from Dhaka University she gained a scholarship to Cambridge University where she continued her studies in English and then attended a Post Graduate Certificate of Education course at the Cambridge Institute of Education.

From 1971-88 she worked for the Inner London Education Authority. Over the last 15 years, she has worked closely with museums and galleries in an attempt to strengthen wider community involvement in the arts. Initially, she worked with museums and with collections of major historical importance as a resource for her teaching and youth work and then as the location for exhibitions she has initiated. "Woven Air, an exhibition celebrating the Kantha and Muslim tradition of Bangladesh, was her original idea and was held at the prestigious Whitechapel Art Gallery in 1988. Also in 1988, she was commissioned by the British Museum to make a collection of rickshaw paintings as part of their permanent collection. The exhibition, at the Museum of Mankind, on "Traffic Art: Rickshaw Paintings of Bangladesh" (1988-91) was widely praised in Britain and abroad. In 1994 she was invited to curate the exhibition at the Fukuoka Art Museum in Japan.

She was awarded the MBE in recognition of the major role she has played to enable the Victoria and Albert Museum to break new ground in establishing links with the wider community.

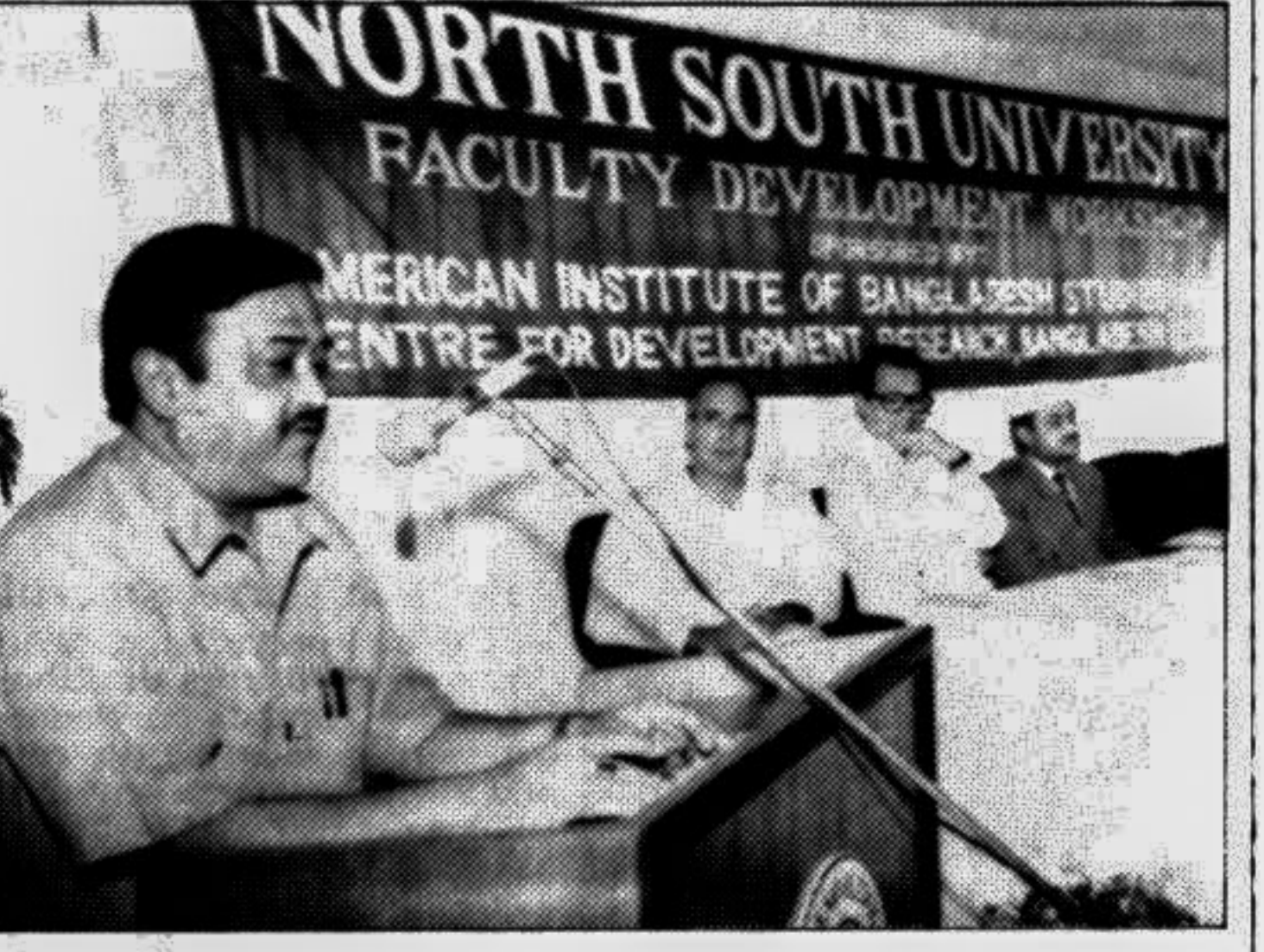

**Workshop on housing begins**

State Minister for Housing and Public Works Asaruddin Ahmad Khan inaugurated a two-day national workshop on community development in human settlements and housing at the auditorium of Planning and Development Academy in the city yesterday, reports UNB.

Vice Chancellor of Jahangirnagar University Prof Amirul Islam Chowdhury presided over the workshop jointly organised by United Nations Centre for Human Settlements (UNCHS) and Centre for Urban Studies (CUS).

It was addressed, among others, by Project Coordinator Prof Nazrul Islam. UNCHS representative Peter Swin and Housing and Public Works Secretary Mukhlesur Rahman, says a PID handout.

"It was unfortunate that the previous governments did not take any remarkable step to solve the housing problems for the urban poor," Khan lamented adding that the present government attaches top priority on housing of the city dwellers.

CHITTAGONG, Aug 24: State Minister for Labour and Manpower M A Mannan today urged the terrorists to return to the right path, reports BSS.

The minister was addressing a grand anti-terrorism rally at the grand Shaheed Minar premises here, organised by the Chittagong Shopowners Association Federation in protest of what they said unabated terrorism in the shops and other business establishments by some identified terrorists.
