## Implementation of NEMAP stressed

Participants at a workshop on National Environment Management Action Plan (NEMAP) have emphasised the implementation of the plan for improving the country's environment and arresting its degradation, reports BSS.

Over one hundred executives, representing different ministries and agencies during their day-long deliberations on NEMAP, held at NEC Bhaban Sunday, examined the NEMAP documents and suggested exploration of dimensions of environmental communication, drawing lessons from Discovery Channel And BBC Earth File and Bangladesh Television. The participants stressed the need for considering a programme on building awareness about weather signals and disasters.

They also suggested formation of a national working committee to oversee and study climate change and sea level rise and initiation of pilot projects with people's participation in selected flood control projects while emphasising on the environmental issue in formulation of flood control projects.

The government officials also underlined the need for attaching higher priority to afforestation, conservation of flora and fauna, wetlands, charlands and Sunderbans while reviewing the existing laws.

They also suggested introduction of environmental demonstration programmes in schools and colleges and curriculum to include environmental education right from primary level and adult literacy programme for raising awareness.

At the inaugural session, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Environment and Forest KM Ehsanul Haq said through the NEMAP exercise, it is learnt that the people at grass-roots level identified their problems well and also gave pragmatic solutions to them.
