Cyberspace Sends Politics Back to the Future

The road to the White House in 1996 will pass through a new state, veteran United States Senator Edward Kennedy said recently about November's pres-

idential election. "You can call it the cyberstate." he explained during a panel discussion at Harvard University in Boston, Masing the Net to provide political information.

PoliticsNow (sic), a service provided by several media organisations, is promising visitors "virtual delegate" status at party conventions. Users will be able to "chat" on-line to politicians and vote in opinion polls on convention issues such as whether they approve of Republican presidential candidate Bob Dole's vet-to-be-announced

This year's US presidential campaign is significant for raising the curtain on a new age of politics by Internet. In her latest cyberspace column for Gemini News Service, Arlene Getz reports that the global computer network can give voters greater access to politicians and debate - offering a return to democratic roots.

sachusetts. "In the process, America will enter a new stage of politics unlike any ever seen before.

This year's presidential race is the first major US election campaign to be fought in the age of the global computer network. the Internet. While cyberspace politics is certainly new, many people believe the system offers a way back to an earlier, more participatory form of democracy in which voters have greater access to candidates and debate.

Kennedy pointed out that politicians saw the advantages of campaigning on the Internet when an experimental link-up a few weeks before the 1992 election attracted thousands of requests for information. This year's campaign has

seen an explosion of electionrelated material on the Internet's World Wide Web information market. Most politicians from presidential candidates to town councillors - have set up sites (electronic information stalls) to spread their views.

Visitors are invited to try their hand at balancing the federal budget or to send electronic mail about issues they think the party should address at its forthcoming convention.

There is a "cafe", where patrons can study a menu listing the shortcomings of Democratic President Bill Clinton's term of office. There is also a "town hall", where Conservative types can meet to discuss the news of the day a "school" and a "post office" Non-partisan organisations are also usrunning mate.

Keen voters like it because they can obtain more detailed. non-intrusive political information than they get in a 30second television commercial And they do not have to contact campaign headquarters or suffer the inconvenience of a pushy telephone canvasser.

For politicians, the ability to reach millions of people at minimal cost improves their prospects for winning support and raising funds. The chance to discuss issues

with candidates and other voters in electronic chat rooms may give users the feeling they have breached the walls of remoteness - opening the door to a more traditional, small-town form of democracy In one early confrontation

between presidential candidates John Kennedy and Richard Nixon in 1960, the latter's appearance - grey suit against grey background, and a strained look after a busy day aggravated by pain from a knee injury - cost him votes and tipped the election against him.

The Internet could change that. Its capacity for transmitting almost limitless amounts of information should allow users to Tocus more en political substance rather than frills such as haircuts and sound

bites As long as the Internet remains an elite medium restricted to those with high-tech computer equipment, it cannot be the springboard for new grassroots movements. But the 1996 election is the first stage the dawn of a new era.


