### Bangabandhu killing 2 students lodge complaint against 13 ex-army officers

A complaint, in connection with the killing of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and 17 others on August 15, 1975, was lodged by two law students with Dhanmondi thana in the city yesterday afternoon.

The complaint was made on the grounds of 'genocide and anti-humanitarian crime'. The officer-in-charge (OC) of Dhanmondi thana received the complaint, explaining that a regular case in this regard could not be filed as a government decision was needed regarding genocide.

OC Md Shafiqullah also mentioned that legal measure would be taken after discussing the matter with the higher authorities, according to the complaint filed with the Dhanmondi thana.

The students who lodged the complaint are: Md. Tayeuddin Khan, son of Md Sayeuddin Khan of Ghoghhat village under Modhukhali thana, Faridpur, and Md. Mohsinul Haq, son of Md. Mizanul Haq of Kalitola under Nagoan district. Tayeuddin is studying LLB at Rajshahi Law College while Mohsinul is a student of LLM at Rajshahi University.

### Obituary

Lulu Bilquis Banu, eldest daughter of Syed Muhammad Taifoor and Begum Sarah Taifoor, died August 31 in London. She had been suffering from renal problems for many years, says a press release.

Lulu Banu began her career in 1958 with Radio Pakistan Dhaka as an announcer and staff artist. After completing her studies in the UK, she returned home in 1953 and joined Vigarunnisa Noon School as deputy head, a post she held for 5 years, followed by a four-year tenure as its headmistress. In later life, she taught remedial English at Colville J M School, London from 1968 to 1979.

During the liberation struggle of 1971, she played a leading role in the 'Free Bangladesh' movement in Britain.

Lulu Banu was married to K A Kamal, bar-at-law, who later became Bangladesh's first ambassador to East Germany. Kamal died in London in 1987. She leaves behind her two daughters, Afsana Kamal Saville and Zareen Sara Kamal, grandson James and many relatives, friends, and admirers.

Lulu Banu's mortal remains will arrive in the city this week. She will be buried at her family graveyard at Siddique Bazar.

Bangladesh Air Force observed the 20th death anniversary of former Chief of Air Staff Air Vice Marshal Khademul Bashar BU, TBt yesterday, says a press release.

### Qulkhwani

The qulkhwani of noted sports organiser Dr Osman Gani will be held today at his residence at House 34, Road 20, Sector 3, Uttara Model Town after Asr prayers, reports BSS.

Dr Gani, former member of Bangladesh Cricket Control Board and founder member of Shantinagar Club, died last Friday at a Singapore hospital. He was 55. He left behind his wife, three daughters and a host of relatives, friend and admirers to mourn his death.

Ahmed Husain, an educationist and Islamic scholar and former director of Islamic Academy (now Islamic Foundation), died of cardiac arrest Saturday. He was 87.

### Concerted efforts needed to curb terrorism: Speaker

Speaker Humayun Rashid Chowdhury yesterday expressed the confidence that terrorism would be eradicated from the country with the joint efforts and sincerity of both the politicians and the law enforcing agencies, reports BSS.

He said the terrorists are terrorists and they do not belong to any political party and terrorism is a disease which must be eradicated from the society.

Chowdhury was speaking as the chief guest at a seminar on 'Role of Leadership in Preserving Parliamentary Democracy and Eradicating Terrorism' held at the Osmani Memorial Auditorium on the occasion of 78th birth anniversary of Bangabir General MAG Osmani, the Commander-in-Chief of the War of Liberation.

The speaker said 'when the political parties especially some political leaders would decide sincerely to eradicate terrorism then it would be removed.' He also said that if the law enforcing agencies were sincere to recover arms then terrorism could not be there.

Referring to parliamentary democracy he said there is no alternative to it for Bangladesh and the government is determined to give parliamentary democracy an institutional shape.

Organised by Bangabir Osmani Smriti Parishad the seminar was addressed, among others, by parliamentary advisor to the Prime Minister Suranjit Sen Gupta, Attorney General Barrister KS Nabi, Segupta Yasmin MP, journalist Santosh Gupta, advisors of the Smriti Parishad Nurul Islam Khan, M A Rashid and M Abdul Halim, former Chief Justice Kamaluddin Hossain, and advocate Sheikh Akhtarul Islam of Jalalabad Association.

President of the parishad Syed Abul Hossain Khawja presided.
