Govt action against BIRDEM authority demanded

The employees Welfare Association of Diabetic Association yesterday sought the government's intervention to stop what it said, the motivated and whimsical activities of the BIRDEM authority, reports BSS.

Speaking at a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club, Kabirul Alam, president and Sheikh Abdus Sattar, general secretary of the association said that the activities of the authority had been pushing the diabetic hospital towards a conflicting situation.

They demanded implementation of the 12-point demand of the association, including the full fledged implementation of the 1992 service rules, and the stopping of contract and daily basis appointments.

They also urged the government to declare the present authority of BIRDEM ineffective and to run the organisation by a permanent committee.

BCL condemns attack on photo-journalists

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), student wing of ruling Awami League, brought out a procession on the Dhaka University campus yesterday and held a rally in front of the Madhu's Canteen protesting the attack on photo-journalists on Tuesday allegedly by BNP activists.

The BCL rally was addressed by the DU unit president Bahadur Bepari, general secretary Abdul Wadud Khokon and organising secretary Sazzad Hosain.

Condemning the attack on the photo-journalists during the election commission gherao programme of BNP on Tuesday, Bahadur Bepari said that BNP oppressed the journalist community during its five-year rule.

He said that Tuesday's attack on the newsmen was nothing but the continuation of BNP's attitude towards the journalists. BCL leaders urged the authorities to arrest and punish those responsible for the attack.

Meanwhile, in a joint statement Enamul Haq Shamim and Ishaque Ali Khan Parina, president and general secretary of BCL respectively, condemned the "brutal" attack on the journalists and demanded exemplary punishment of those responsible.
