Tahfiz-e-Haramine Parishad Bangladesh yesterday called upon the authorities to form "Haj advisory council" which should be constituted by experienced alem and responsible citizens to formulate a proper and permanent Haj policy for the country, reports BSS.

Maulana Sadek Ahmed Sidiqui, president of the parishad put forward several suggestions which inter alia includes reducing of air fare for both ballotees and non-ballotees, a full-fledged office of Bangladesh Hajamati at Makka fitted with computer facilities, strengthening of Haj mission and its medical team and completion of permanent Haj camp before the onset of the next Haj season.

In a statement, he said if air fare could be brought down within Taka 30 thousand, arrangements to go to Saudi Arabia for Haj by sea was taken and facilities for Hajis were raised, the number of people able to perform Haj would exceed fifty thousand.

Obituary


Noted educationist and social worker Amena Begum died at BIRDEM Hospital in the city Thursday night. She was 70, reports BSS.
