Met office said weather may remain mainly dry with partly cloudy sky elsewhere over the country during the next 12 hours till 6 pm today.

Slight fall in day temperature is expected across the country during the period.

Weathermen forecast that rainfall activities may increase in the next two days while a little change likely in the subsequent five days.

'Transit only if India resolves other bilateral issues'

Speakers at a seminar on "Security of Bangladesh and Transit" observed that Indo-Bangladesh transit issue could only be given serious consideration if India proved its credentials as a good neighbour.

The seminar, held at the Jatiya Press Club in the city yesterday, was organised by Janashmaj. It was conducted by Lutfur Rahman Shahjahan.

Mafizul Huq presented a keynote paper while Sadek Khan, Ahmad Safa, Dr Ahmed Kamal and Dr Altabuddin Ahmed were the discussants. The keynote paper was prepared jointly by Ferdous Hossain, Muniruddin Ahmed, Abul Hasib Khan, Shahidul Islam, Golam Mahmud, Mafizul Huq and Nurul Islam.

"The transit issue between India and Bangladesh is being discussed when the 25-year friendship treaty is nearing its expiry, and issues like the

Ganges water, Muhurir char, control of Talpatti, push-in, Shantibahini, Chakma refugees, fencing of borders, observation tower, Bangabandhu movement and the demarcation of sea territory are yet to be resolved," the paper noted.

How the issue of transit could even crop up when many long standing bilateral issues between India and Bangladesh could not be resolved, questioned Sadek Khan, a journalist.

Ahmed Safa blamed the leadership of the country for lacking vision to match the need of the time. He also urged that the people of the country have to be brought out of their psychological dependence on others.

Dr Ahmed Kamal demanded preparation of a position paper on transit issue by experts and its mass circulation among the people before a decision is made in that regard.

Rather than going for the transit issue bilaterally, Bangladesh should make other neighbouring countries involved on the question of transit with India, observed Dr Altabuddin Ahmed, a teacher of the Dhaka University.

Women's welfare team calls on President

President Abdur Rahman Biswas yesterday said the women should come forward along with the men for the social and economic development of the country, reports AFP.

President Biswas was talking to a delegation of the Muslim Women's Welfare Organisation who called on him at Bangabhaban.

President of the organisation, Begum Tahmina led the delegation.

Referring to the basic needs of the people of the country like housing, medicare and education, the President said with the change of time the womenfolk could render their valuable services for the fulfilment of the basic needs of the people.

President Biswas referred to the movement for women's liberation in India since the British period and said they had to go a long way in overcoming innumerable social barriers.

He said the women of Bangladesh are in a better position to realise their demand since the Prime Minister and the leader of the Opposition are both women. During the previous regime, the Prime Minister and the leader of the Opposition were also women, the President said adding the women should organise themselves for the betterment of the country.
