NARAYANGANJ, Sept 15: A father and his daughter were electrocuted when they came in contact with a live wire at their home at village Purba Para Mizmizi, under Siddhirganj thana here this morning.

Abdul Matin, 55, was electrocuted in a failed bid to rescue his daughter Lipli, 35, as the latter came in contact with a loose live wire at eight in the morning.

Both the bodies were sent to Narayanganj General Hospital morgue for autopsy while two unnatural death cases were registered with the Siddhirganj thana in this connection.

Obituary

Khalilur Rahman, a former superintendent of police, died of cancer yesterday in Boston, Massachusetts, USA, a few hours after his 75th birthday, says a press release.

He will be buried in a Muslim graveyard near Reston, Virginia after namaz-e-jaanaza at Albany New York Mosque and Islamic Centre.

Rahman who hailed from Mymensingh, joined the police service in Calcutta and served in various capacities in the police department before and after the independence of Bangladesh. He also served in Bangladesh embassies in Thailand and Nepal.

He has left behind his wife, two sons, a daughter and many relatives and admirers to mourn his death.

PASOL seminar in city from Sept 21

The 25th annual Pacific Area Senior Officer Logistics Seminar (PASOLS) will be held in Dhaka September 21-26, says a USIS press release.

Bangladesh Army chief Lieutenant General Muhammad Mahbubur Rahman, psc and Al-fred G Volkman, US Assistant Deputy Secretary of Defence for Armaments Cooperation, will open the inaugural session. Major General Mohammad Anwar Hossain, BP, psc, Chief of General Staff, Bangladesh Army, and Brigadier General Dennis K Jackson, Director of Logistics and Security Assistance, US Pacific Command, will co-chair the conference. Ambassador Charles B Salmon, Jr, foreign policy advisor to the Commander in Chief, US Pacific Command, will give the keynote address.

PASOLS is a nonpolitical forum of senior military and ministry-level logisticians from countries in the Pacific-Indian Ocean region. The seminar will bring together more than 125 delegates from as many as 35 nations to exchange ideas and information on topical logistics issues of concern to all. Delegates will discuss strategies for handling military logistics problems in the 1990s.

The theme for this year's seminar is "Logistics Cooperation - Keeping it Simple." Panel discussions and plenary sessions will emphasize fostering regional cooperation among Pacific and Indian Ocean nations. This year's panel topics will include a Bangladesh case study involving the need for harmony between civilian and military elements to provide logistical support during contingency operations. Other topics include Pacific area cooperative acquisition and logistics support initiatives.
