Water scarcity acute in city's Shantibagh area

Water scarcity has turned acute again in Shantibagh central road and Masjid road areas for the last one week, reports UNB.

Local leaders said the deep tubewell, commissioned last month on the persistent demand of the citizens of the area, has been in operation but for unknown reasons the residences along the two roads were going dry.

The abrupt water crisis has been causing deep anguish among the residents particularly during the current hot spell.

The Shantibagh-Shahidbagh-Shajahanpur Janakalyan Samity has expressed concern over the acute crisis of water in the areas and demanded immediate resolution of the problem.

In a joint statement, Tuesday vice president C G M Kamal, general secretary Prof Kazi Joynal Abedin and treasurer Kamaluddin Ahmad said the situation has been making life miserable in the area.

A WASA official when contacted on telephone told UNB that they were looking into the possibility of any technical problem or irregularity in the pump.

He said the high temperature in the country has been causing frequent voltage fluctuations which make the pump inoperative. Load-shedding may also be a cause, he added.
