**Dy Speaker meets counterpart in Beijing**

Deputy Speaker Abdul Hamid Advocate, now visiting China, met with his Chinese counterpart Wang Hanbin at the International Convention Centre in Beijing yesterday, reports UNB.

The Deputy Speaker is leading a Bangladesh delegation to the 96th Conference of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU) in Beijing.

During the meeting, Wang Hanbin, vice chairman of the standing committee of the National People's Congress of China, expressed satisfaction over the existing excellent bilateral relations between the two countries and said the two countries held common positions on international issues.

Wang Hanbin also hoped that the two countries would continue to cooperate in international forums for global peace, said a press release.

The Deputy Speaker reciprocated the sentiment expressed by his Chinese counterpart and said that the relations between Bangladesh and China are at a new heightened level with the just concluded visit of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to China.

Abdul Hamid also hoped that economic cooperation between the two countries would further be strengthened due to this visit.

**Govt urged to provide grant for Noori's treatment**

The Ramgati Samity in Dhaka yesterday appealed to the government for financial grant to meet the treatment expenses of ailing journalist Sanaullah Noori, reports UNB.

An eminent journalist-litérateur and editor of the Daily Dinkal, Sanaullah Noori is now under treatment for gangrene at Singapore General Hospital.

Convener of the Samity A H M Noman told a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club in the city yesterday that Noori's family was facing financial crisis paying the treatment expenses of 2,000 US dollars per week.

Noori, who has been advised to continue the treatment for another month, will be compelled to return home without completing the treatment if financial grant is not provided to him.

It appealed to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and voluntary organisations to come forward with generous assistance to save the life of the noted journalist who hails from Ramgati thana of Laximpur district.

Samity's Joint Convener M Jasim Uddin and M Atiqullah were present at the press conference among others.

**Int'l seminar on military justice system concludes**

The international seminar on military justice system, organised jointly by the Bangladesh Armed Forces and Naval Justice School of the United States, concluded at the Armed Forces Medical Institute auditorium in the city yesterday, reports BSS.

Arranged by Bangladesh Navy, the five-day seminar was participated by senior officers of the US Naval Justice School, Bangladesh Army, Navy, Air Force, Bangladesh Rifles, Bangladesh Coast Guard, representatives of different ministries and other government and non-government organisations, to develop an understanding on the rule of law, military justice system and disciplined military operations, an ISPR press release said.

Attorney General Barrister K S Nabi was the chief guest on the concluding day of the seminar and distributed certificates among the participants.

Earlier, Captain M F K Khan, Judge Advocate General of Bangladesh Navy, read out a resume of the seminar. Colonel John Bond Atkinson of the US Naval Justice School also spoke on the occasion.

**NSU MBA course from May '97 likely**

North-South University (NSU) is expected to start its Master of Business Administration course from May next year, Muslehuddin Ahmad, president of NSU said yesterday, reports BSS.

Briefing newsmen at the university campus in the city, Ahmad said the curricula for the MBA programme of the NSU was being prepared in collaboration with certain leading universities of the United States of America.

The NSU, a private sector university, which began its journey in January 1993 with 133 students, now has more than 1100 students. It has four undergraduate and one master's programme.

The NSU president said that the university is going to hold its first convocation in December this year. About 100 students would be graduating from the university by that time, he added.

**Tk 15 lakh IUB scholarships offered in '95**

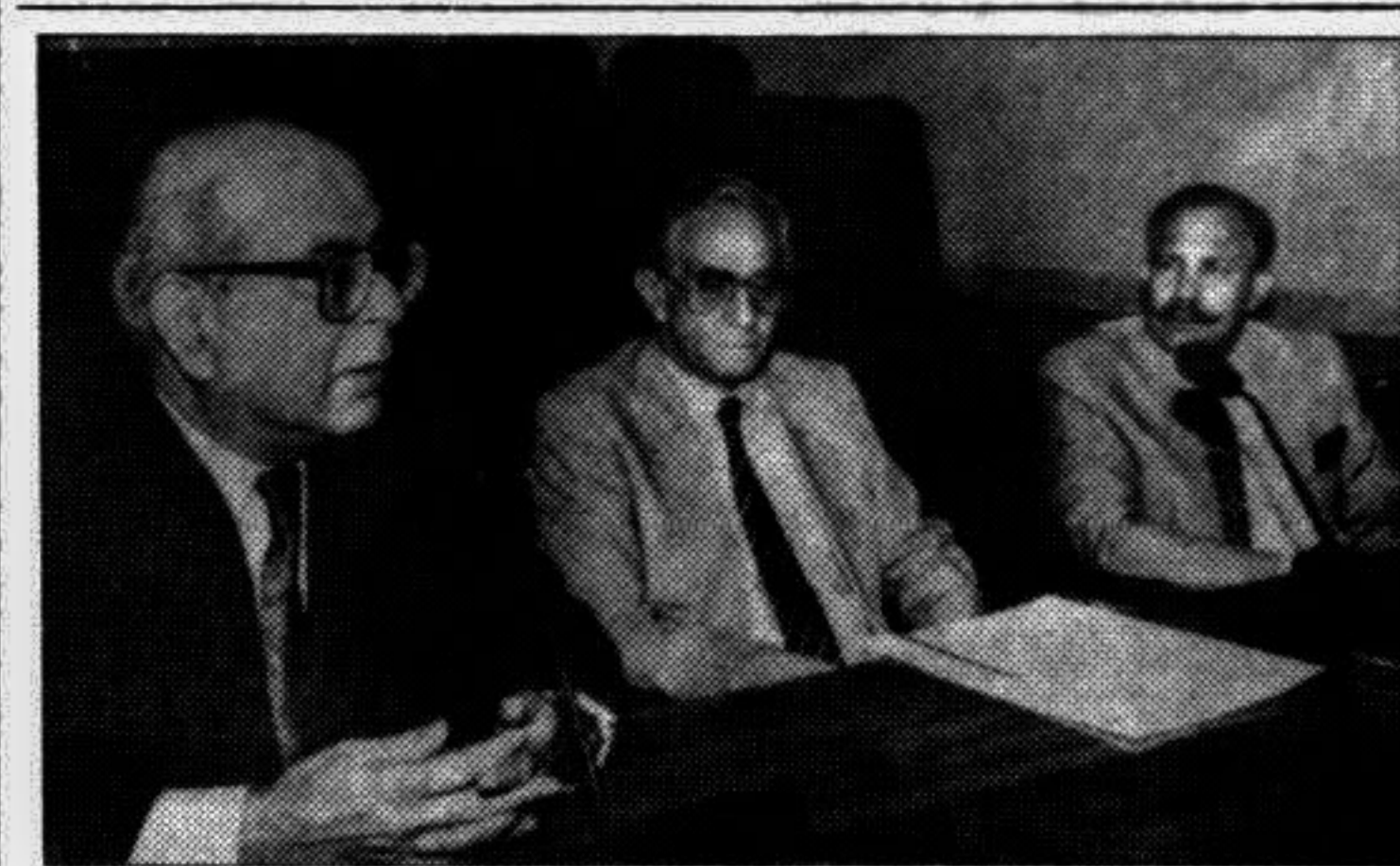
The Independent University, Bangladesh (IUB) offered scholarships worth over Taka 15 lakh to its meritorious poor students in 1995, reports BSS.

The university also gave Tk 12,40,000 was scholarships during the first semester in 1996, a press release of the university said yesterday.
