Thundershower likely

Light to moderate rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind is likely at many places over Dhaka, Barisal, Chittagong divisions and at a few places over Rajshahi, Sylhet. Khulna divisions in the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

The Met Office said day temperature may remain nearly unchanged during the period across the country.

The country's highest temperature 33.7 degree Celsius was recorded at Satkhira and the lowest, 23.3 degrees, at Barisal yesterday.

Meantime, Comilla experienced the highest 38 mm rain in 24 hours till 6 am yesterday. Cox's Bazar had 28 mm rain, Sylhet 25, Faridpur 24 and Barisal 8 mm shower during the period.

Media's role in fighting drug abuse stressed

Speakers at a seminar yesterday underscored the need for adopting a positive and integrated approach by the media to make their role beneficial for a lasting and meaningful solution to the problem of drug abuse in the SAARC region, reports BSS.

The inaugural session of the two-day long SAARC seminar on "The role of mass media in drug abuse prevention" was held at a city hotel.

The participants said the media can formulate, mould and shape public opinion against the menace of drug abuse.

They also expressed the hope that the delegates of the SAARC

countries would find out a concrete strategy to be pursued by the mass media in their future fight to save the people from the clutches of drugs.

Jointly organised by SAARC Secretariat and the Department on Narcotics Control, Bangladesh, the seminar is being participated by the delegates from India, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and host Bangladesh.

Organisers said the seminar, first of its kind in Bangladesh, is aimed at evolving ways and means to strengthen the mass media in its fight against drug abuse.

The inaugural session was addressed by former Cabinet Secretary M Mujibul Huq as the chief guest, Director General of the Department of Narcotics Control Nazmul Ahsan Chowdhury and Director of the Department of Narcotics Control Shaiful Islam.

In his speech, Mujibul Huq said the deliberations of the delegates would open up new avenues of cooperation to effectively combat the menace of drug abuse in this region.

Addiction to drug not only impairs physical and mental health, but also disrupts family and social relationship, he added.

Huq said that side by side with the government efforts, other social organisations and NGOs also should effectively contribute to curb the menace of drug abuse.

He said that the role of mass media is very important in motivating people against this social menace. Mentioning the important role of newspapers in carrying the message to the common people, he said the people believe in what they read in print.

He also said that the radio and television are also most powerful in dissemination of ideas among people in order to motivate and mobilise them for a social cause.

Nazmul Ahsan Chowdhury underlined the need for countering the drug-traffickers through law enforcement.

Motivational approaches, he said, could be undertaken by NGOs and the mass media alongside the government efforts.
