 At last, he added, it was decided to introduce a two-digit telephone for the Fire Services control room.

EC assistance sought to solve flood problem

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzaq yesterday sought technical assistance from European Commission to solve the recurring flood problem, reports UNB.
 The Minister sought the co-operation when a three member delegation of European Commission called on him at his secretariat, Michael Drury was the head of delegation of the Commission.
 During the meeting, they discussed on various aspect of the water resources, flood problem and its solution, said a PID handout.
 The Minister briefed the delegation about the reasons of flood in the country saying that most of the rivers have become silted up. He also said the existing dredging system of the country is not enough and effective to meet the problem.

Michael Drury assured to provide all sorts of technical assistance to solve the siltation problem of the rivers in Bangladesh.
 Secretary of Water Resources Dr A T M Shamsul Huda was present.
