Abul Hasan in Singapore Business leaders urged to invest in Bangladesh

State Minister for Foreign Affairs Abul Hasan Chowdhury spent a busy day yesterday giving interviews to the electronic media on the second day of his visit to Singapore, according to a message received in the city, reports BSS.

In the morning the Television Corporation of Singapore, Radio Singapore International and Asia Business News Television separately interviewed the Bangladesh state minister.

Chowdhury elaborated the government's policies on trade and investment and the latest political situation in Bangladesh.

He urged the investors and business leaders of Singapore to invest in Bangladesh, where all sorts of facilities are given to the foreign investors, including tax holiday and repatriation of their profit.

1110 bottles of phensidyl seized

A special squad of the Department of Narcotics Control (DNC) recovered a huge quantity of India phensidyl syrup from Syedabad area in the city Thursday, reports UNB.

Acting on a tip-off, the squad led by Deputy Director Khabir-uddin Ahmed raided a den of drug addicts at Balurmath in Syedabad at about 2 pm and seized 1110 bottles phensidyl.

They also arrested one Mohammad Nur Hossain, 22, in this connection, said a press release.

Earlier, on Sunday, they recovered 1258 bottles of phensidyl from the same area and arrested one Mohammad Babu in this connection, the press release said.

Dhaka Governor of Intelset

Bangladesh for the first time has become the Governor of the Asia-Pacific Group of Intelset for a term of one year, reports UNB.

The selection was made at the 112th meeting of Intelset Board of Governors held at Washington, USA, recently.

Chairman of Bangladesh Telegraph and Telephone Board MH Chowdhury was nominated as governor to represent Bangladesh at the meeting, said a press release.

Chowdhury returned home on Monday after attending the meeting. The Asia-Pacific Group members are: Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea and Fiji.

Moizuddin's death anniversary observed

The 12th death anniversary of renowned Awami League leader and former MP, Mohammad Moizuddin, a martyr of the anti-autocracy movement, was observed yesterday in a befitting manner, reports BSS.

Paying rich tributes to Moizuddin, Awami League leader Amir Hossain Amu said only through institutionalising democracy and building up a terrorism and corruption-free society, the nation could pay proper respect to Moizuddin and other martyrs.

Addressing a memorial meeting at the central office of the party, Amu recalled the courageous role of late Moizuddin in building up resistance against the illegal government of Mushtaque after the assassination of the Father of the Nation, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

Moizuddin, a noted organiser of the independence war and convener of Agartala conspiracy case conducting committee, was the honorary secretary general of Bangladesh Family Planning Association and vice chairman of Bangladesh Red Crescent Society.

Awami League leader Mozfar Hossain Paltu spoke on the occasion as the special guest, while it was chaired by city AL senior vice president Rezauddin Ahmed, Siddiqur Rauf Khan, advocate Sahara Khatun, Fazlur Rahman, Akhtarul Alam, advocate, Qamrul Islam, Foyezuddin Mia, Abu Mostafa Mahmudunnabi and Salahuddin Badal also spoke.

Meanwhile, in Kaligonj, the home town of the late leader, where he was assassinated during the anti-autocracy movement in 1984, the local Awami League took up elaborate programmes in observance of his death anniversary.

Attack on poet Abdul Hye Sikdar condemned

Amanullah Kabir, and Zahirul Haque, president and secretary general respectively of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists, Abu Saleh, acting president and Ruhul Amin Gazi, general secretary of Dhaka Union of Journalists, Thursday condemned the attack on poet Abdul Hye Sikdar, assistant editor of weekly Bichitra and an executive committee member of DUJ, reports BSS.

In a joint statement, they said it was not an isolated incident as he was being threatened over telephone during the past few days.

Rezauddin Ahmed, president and Khondker Manirul Alam, general secretary of the Jatiya Press Club, in another statement, expressed their great concern at the attack on poet Abdul Hye Sikdar on Wednesday.

They urged the government, particularly the Home Ministry, to nab the culprits and give them punishment. They also urged the government to provide proper medicare to Sikdar, who is now under treatment at Dhaka Medical College Hospital. They prayed for Sikdar's early recovery.

BDRCS relief for flood victims of Dhalpur

Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) at a function yesterday distributed relief materials among the flood-affected people of Dhalpur under Ward No 85 of the Dhaka City Corporation, reports BSS.

Ward Commissioner and one of the member of the managing board of the society, Khalekuzzaman Chowdhury, addressed the function as the chief guest, a press release said.

In his speech, Chowdhury urged the present government to take necessary steps to aid the people affected by river erosion.

Chowdhury, who is also a former deputy mayor of the city and ex-chairman of the Dhaka City Unit Red Crescent Society, urged the rich people and the youths to render their services for the cause of humanity.

Sirajul Alam, vice-chairman of the city unit Red Crescent Society, Swapon, secretary general of the city unit and Zafar Ullah, assistant director of the Red Crescent Society, among others, spoke at the function.

Founder-president of the Purba Dhalpur Social Welfare Association, SM Ismail chaired the function.

Weather Heavy rainfall forecast

Moderately heavy rainfall is likely at places over Chittagong, Barisal and Khulna divisions in the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

The Met Office also forecast light to moderate rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind at many places over Chittagong, Barisal, Khulna divisions and at a few places over Dhaka, Sylhet, Rajshahi divisions.

In its outlook for subsequent two days, weathermen predicted improved weather while forecast little change in the following five days.

Day temperature may remain nearly unchanged during the period across the country.

Meantime, Bhola experienced the highest 59 mm rain during the last 36 hours till 6 pm yesterday. Rajshahi had 35 mm rain, Khepupara 33 and Mymensingh 19mm shower during the period.

The country's highest temperature 32.5 degree Celsius, was recorded at Sylhet and the lowest, 23.4 degrees, at Kutubdia. The sun sets today at 5:49 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:51 am. Maximum and minimum temperatures and humidity recorded in some major cities and towns yesterday were:
