Teacher-guardian assoc in govt colleges opposed

The BCS General Education Association opposed to an Education ministry directive that asked the principals of government colleges to form teacher-guardian association, reports UNB.

"Such association will invite unwanted local interference in the college administration," said a press release of the association Friday.

The release, signed by association general secretary Prof Md Abu Yusuf, said there is no necessity of a teacher-guardian association in government colleges which are under direct control of the Directorate and the Ministry.

Expressing their resentment about the decision, the association demanded withdrawal of the circular issued by the Education Secretary of the caretaker government, calling for the formation of such association by September 30.

It said the matter was placed with the Prime Minister for a review during her meeting with the association on September 22.

The association had earlier opposed a similar initiative by the BNP regime. It was later resolved at a principals' conference in presence of the then Education Minister.

The principals' conference held in 1995 had suggested formation of teachers' council instead of the teacher-guardian association for better running of the college administration.

Menon for reforms in land admin

The Workers Party general secretary said although the rural sector is contributing a lot in the national development, but the budgetary allocation is very low.

He called upon the rural landless and Khetmajur union to gear up the organisational activities for improving their own lot.

President urged not to attend CMUJ confce

Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) yesterday called upon President Abdur Rahman Biswas not to attend the conference of Chittagong Metropolitan Union of Journalists (CMUJ), scheduled to be held today, a BFUJ press release said, reports BSS.

In a joint statement, BFUJ acting president Kartik Chatterjee and secretary general M Shajahan Mia and DUJ president Abul Kalam Azad and general secretary Azizul Islam Bhuiyan said that the participation of the President at the conference of a controversial union would tarnish the constitutional position of the head of the state.

They said that Chittagong Union of Journalists (CUJ) is the only legal trade union of the journalists of the port city while CMUJ was formed by a section of politically motivated persons with which the larger section of the journalists has no link. "The President, who does not belong to any party should not side with a 'microscopic' faction of the journalists who are out to disrupt the greater unity and integrity of the community," they added.

Noted journalist Obaidul Haq said the book, in which the readers find pleasure, is a good book.

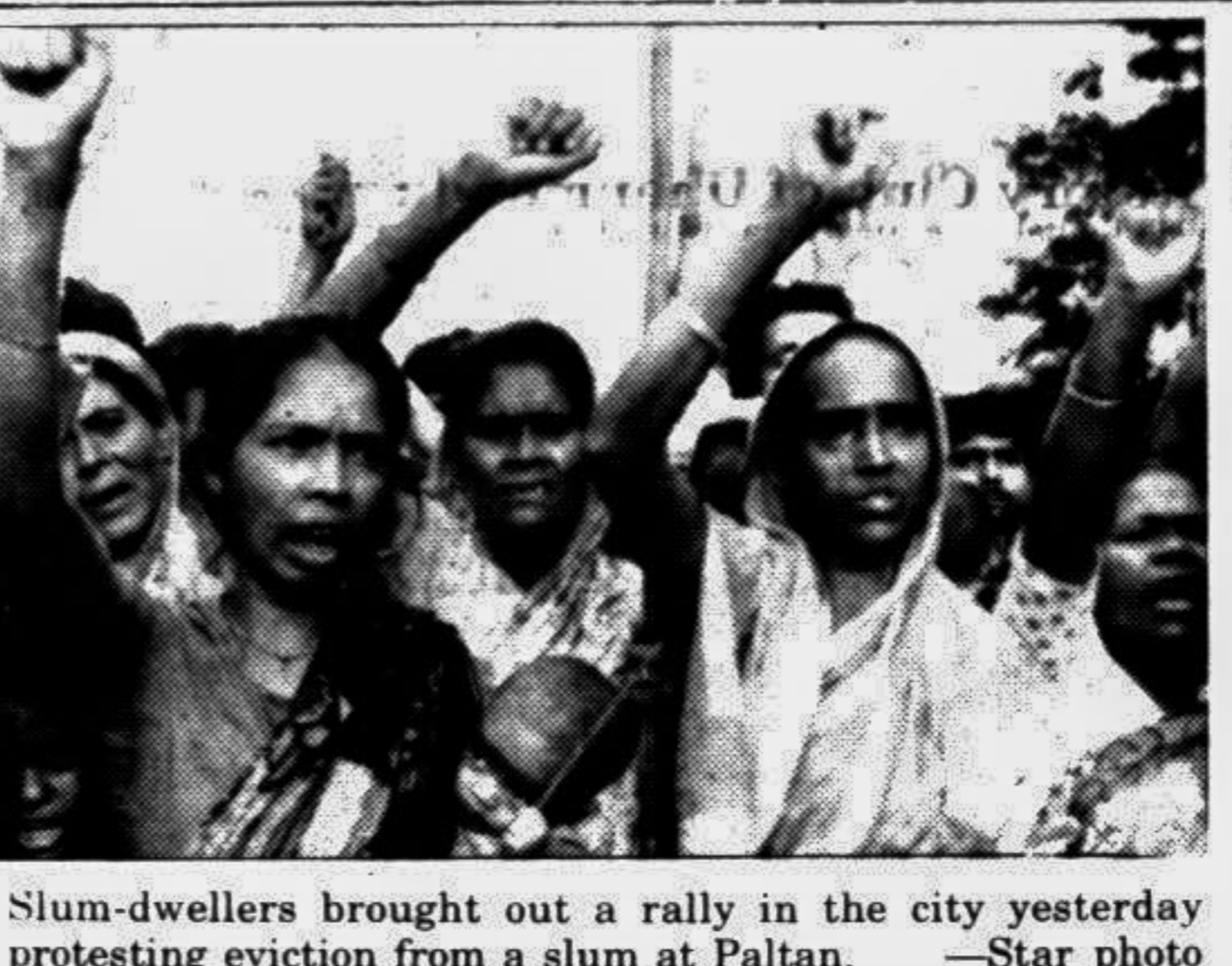
