Tk 2.12 cr grant provided to Prabin Sangha

State Minister for Social Welfare. Women and Children's Affairs Dr Mozammel Hossain vesterday said that the government has already provided a grant of Tk 2.12 crore to the Bangladesh Prabin Hitoishi Sangha and Jarabigyan Pratisthan for its development and expansion, reports BSS.

The state minister said the elderly constitute six per cent of the Bangladeshi population now and would rise to seven per cent by the year 2000.

At the function, Abdur Rouf and Nurun Nahar were handed over awards for their services to the elderly.

PM urged to take steps against arsenic pollution

Executives of five-non-governmental development agencies and forums have appealed to the Prime Minister to investigate and take necessary steps against arsenic contamination of tubewell water in different parts of the country, reports

The agencies and forums also suggested to constitute a commission with scientists. health and water experts, government officials and NGO representatives and leading citizens to investigate arsenic contamination and take remedial measures, according to a press release on Monday.

They said press reports suggested that presence of arsenic in tubewell waters in at least 15 districts had increased to an alarming level and claimed 50 lives and nearly ten lakh people were affected.

They said that confusions were there about the cause of arsenic contamination as various reports have attributed to various reasons behind the contamination. Consequently people are being scared of it. Under such a situation, the

NGO associations and forums have suggested certain measures including determining the sources of contamination. analysis of arsenic presence and constitution of commission to find out the real cause of it and suggest measures to get rid

of the deadly problem. They also called for taking necessary measures for treatment and rehabilitation of the affected persons. They underscored the need for ascertaining whether people had died of ar senic contamination and if so, the affected families should be given compensation.

They also suggested alternative measures for providing pure drinking water in the affected areas. They also suggested massive campaign through radio and television and other mass media to make the people aware of the problem.




