

Abul Khair accorded reception

Abul Khair, the 9-year old boy who saved hundreds of lives by flagging down a train near Hajiganj station in Chandpur district three months ago, was honoured by the Rotary Club of Metropolitan Dhaka (RCMD) at a reception yesterday, reports UNB.

The RCMD is financing his education through Class X in recognition of his bravery.

The reception, held at Hajiganj primary school where Khair studies, was organised to mark the opening of an account in his name at a local bank.

He will now be able to draw

Tk 500 a month from the bank account for his educational expenses, the RCMD said in a press release.

Presided over by Abdur Rashid Majumder, chairman of Hajiganj pourashava, the function was addressed by Past Rotary District Governor Magduruddin Ahmed, RCMD leaders MA Matin, Dr Muhammad Ahsan, Farid Hossain and a number of local elite.

The RCMD leaders said their club is ready to support Khair's educational expenses beyond Class X as long as he continues his studies.
