

## **Violation of code of ethics** hampering media growth'

Journalists and academi cians yesterday observed that healthy growth of journalism is adversely affected in the country by frequent violations of professional code of ethics by media professionals, reports

They underlined the need for following the code of ethics while writing a news report and publishing it, to put an end to 'yellow' journalism and undue control to suppress news only to serve vested interests.

The speakers were addressing a workshop on "reporting ethics and practices," organised by Dhaka Reporters Unity (DRU) at a city hotel yesterday. The workshop was presided

over by DRU vice president Anwarul Huq. Veteran journalists Ataus Samad, Syed Kamaluddin of Far-Eastern Economic Review, Golam Tahboor, chief of the Dhaka Bureau of AFP and Associated Professor Ahaduzzaman Mohammad Ali of Journalism and Mass Communication Department of Dhaka University spoke on the occasion as resource persons.

Samad underlined the need for an institution which would effectively help maintain ethics

Golam Tahboor said it was unfortunate to see that ethics is violated frequently in newspaper reporting by suppression of essential facts. He pointed out that ethics

was often violated in case of reporting rape incidents in Bangladeshi newspapers. He said ethics did not allow the reporter to give complete identity of the rape victims.




