# Rain multiplies miseries of flood-hit peasants

PABNA, Oct 9: Having rainfall on October 5 night all over the district has not only inundated vast areas afresh but also made over two lakhs of day-labourers and landless peasants completely jobless. At least light lakh men, women and children, dependent fully on the day-labourers and landless peasants, have been passing their days in miseries. Fresh rainfall has caused huge loss to the farmers and the agricultural labourers as well. The losses they suffered earlier during three consecutive floods which were accompanied with

erosion were yet to be regained. Their destroyed houses could not be rebuilt for want of money. The corrugated huts that were distributed were extremely meagre to meet the minimum requirements. Meanwhile, the cultivation of all local variety of aman paddy, all sorts of winter vegetables like potato, tomato, cauliflower have been facing setback. Cultivation of "Mash Kalai," wheat, mustard seeds, other varieties of pulses has become virtually impossible as water recession from the agricultural

fields was not completed. Agriculture rehabilitation scheme might not be succeeded due to fresh rainfalls. Water logging caused by renewed rain stands heavily on the way of augmenting cultivation. While talking to this correspondent the Deputy Director, Agriculture Extension Department, Pabna, however, said that the situation was not completely frustrating as the unaffected areas were still expected to produce a good yield of aman paddy. He, however, admitted that the cultivation of potato, mustard seeds, pulses of some varieties, wheat and all sorts of winter vegetables would suffer most. Meanwhile, reaction of the above situation is extremely sharp in the market. Prices of pulses and vegetables of all sorts have gone abnormally high in the market. Many of such commodities are in extremely short supply in the market. Prices of wheat and 'ata' have been steadily rising. It was gathered.

MOULVIBAZAR, Oct 9: A young woman was allegedly raped by miscreants. According to police source, the heinous incident took place at the village Salan under Kulara thana of the district recently.

It is gathered that the victims, Sumati Rani Sen, 20, daughter of Manindra Kumer Sen, on the night of incident came out of her house to respond to nature's call. But she never returned. In the last hour of the same night, Chairman of Tilagaon Union Parishad informed the Srimgong GRP police over telephone that a dead body of a young woman was found on the railway line near Monu railway station.

After receiving information, police recovered the body and identified the victim as Sumati Rani Sen. Police suspected that the victim was killed after a gang rape. Her left leg was found detached from the body.

# Four awarded life, five 10 years RI

MOULVI BAZAR, Oct 9: Four persons were awarded life term and five others were given 10 years rigorous imprisonment (RI) in two separate cases recently.

According to reports, two people were sentenced to suffer life imprisonment and five others to suffer ten years RI in a dacoity case. The court also fined all of them Taka 10 thousand each, in default to suffer 2 years more RI each.

The Additional District and Sessions Judge Abdul Gafur announced the judgment recently. Those who were awarded life term imprisonment, tried in absentia were: Meshuk Miah and Ataur Rahman, Sajjad Surman Ali, Akmal Ali, Akber Ali, and Asgar Ali were awarded 10 years RI.

The prosecution story in brief is that on June 18, 1993 a dacoity was committed at the house of one Hafiz Abdul Hamid of village East Gualbari under Baraktha thana of the district. The dacoits looted valuables including cash, money and gold ornaments from the house.

House-master Hafiz Abdul Hamid lodged a dacoity case against 10 people with Baraktha thana, and the police subsequently submitted charge-sheets against all the 10 accused.

## At last chairman after 8 years!

MOULVIBAZAR, Oct 9: After 8 years of election, chairman of Mousurnagar Union Parishad (UP) under Tajnagar thana of the district has taken oath of his office recently.

The Thana Nirbahi Officer (TNO) of Rajnagar thana conducted oath of office to Tahir Uddin as UP Chairman following an order of Local Government, Rural Development (LGRD) Ministry.

It is mentioned here that Tahir Uddin was elected chairman of Mousurnagar Union Parishad on February 10, 1988 with a narrow margin of votes. But after election, his nearest rival alleged that the election was unfair and a large scale of rigging took place during the election in favour of Tahiruddin. He also filed cases one after another against the election result.

As a result, elected chairman Tahir Uddin was not given the charge of the union according to procedure. But verdict of all cases went in favour of Tahir.

From 1988 onwards, the day-to-day activities of the union parishad was run by a government appointed administrator. In the meantime, after final verdict of all cases, the LGRD Ministry decided to hand over the chairmanship to Tahir Uddin.

Taking over chairmanship after 8 years of election, Tahir Uddin expressed his disappointment saying the period of chairmanship was not decided by the ministry.

Meanwhile, according to a recent declaration, the next UP election will be held in December.

## Three to suffer 10 yrs RI for violating minor girl

KISHOREGANJ, Oct 9: Three persons including a woman were sentenced to suffer 10 years rigorous imprisonment (RI) in a rape case on October 3.

Md Shahidullah, Additional Session and Special Tribunal Judge of Kishoreganj also fined Abdul Mannan, Genu Mia and Haresa (absconding) Taka 3000 each.

According to the prosecution story, on March 11, 1995 at about 1 pm accused Haresa called Khodeza Khatun, a minor girl of village Mulsatal in Kishoreganj sadar thana in her house on plea of some important business. Haresa then left the scene keeping Khodeza inside her house where Mannan and Genu were waiting. The two accused then raped her one after another keeping the door closed from inside.

A case was registered with Kishoreganj police who after investigation submitted charge-sheet against Abdul Mannan, Genu Mia and Haresa leading to the trial in the court of Additional Session and Special Tribunal Judge.

## Illegal arms recovered: 3 college students held

BRAHMANBARIA, Oct 9:

Three students of Brahmanbaria government College were arrested on October 1 for allegedly possessing illegal arms and ammunition, reports UNB.

Police said on the basis of secret information, they arrested Shahrar Khan Shiblu, and his two associates Abu Musa and Mainul Islam from the college campus. Police also recovered a revolver with five rounds of bullets from Shiblu at the time. Another message adds: Akhaura police arrested four people from an engine boat at Tourpura village and recovered 100 bottles of phenistyl syrup on the night of September 29. # Four awarded life, five 10 years RI

MOULVI BAZAR, Oct 9: Four persons were awarded life term and five others were given 10 years rigorous imprisonment (RI) in two separate cases recently.

After examining witnesses and records, the learned Additional Judge awarded the aforesaid punishment. In another judgement, the Additional District and Sessions Judge Abdul Gafur sentenced two persons to suffer life-imprisonment on charge of murder and fined them Taka five thousand each in default to suffer one month more imprisonment each. The learned judge delivered the judgement recently.

The prosecution story of this case was that, one Shafigue Miah of village Tajpur under Biance bazar thana of Sylhet district was living in a rented house at Raghurandan Pur area of Moulvibazar town. Early hours of 30 August, 1987, a group of criminals shot him dead at his rented house.

Piara Begum, wife of the victim Shafigue Miah filed a murder case with Moulvibazar thana against 3 persons namely Mohammed Ali, alias Waris Ali, Shaheed Miah and Babul Miah.

The investigation officer after investigation submitted charge-sheet against the three accused.

The learned Additional Judge, after examining the records and witnesses, awarded the aforesaid punishment.

## Two found guilty of possessing arms

JHENIDAH, Oct 9:

Two members of an outlawed party were awarded rigorous imprisonment (RI) for possessing illegal arms, court sources said today, reports UNB.

Nazrul alias Raza was awarded 10 years RI with a fine of Tk 1000, Kalam alias Sohel was awarded seven years RI with a fine of Tk 500.

According to prosecution, Raza and Sohel along with six people were caught red-handed on October 18, 1993 by the people of Biddadharpur village in Moheshpur thana and they were handed over to the police with recovered fire arms including pistol and three rounds of bullets.

Additional District and Sessions Judge Abdul Aziz Khalifa awarded punishment on September 29 after examining the witnesses and records. Other six were acquitted.

## One found guilty of killing mother, imprisoned for life

MOULVIBAZAR, Oct 9: Hasan Ali of village Montail under Kulara thana of the district has been awarded life imprisonment for killing his mother.

The District and Sessions Judge A K M Fazlul Karim delivered the judgment recently. The court also fined him Taka 5,000.

According to prosecution story, Hasan Ali, son of Mahtab Miah killed his mother Hazera Begum following a family feud on April 20, 1994. Local choudkider informed the incident to Jafarnagar Union Chairman. After receiving the information from the Union Parishad, police of Kulara thana arrested the Hasan Ali and after investigation issued charge-sheet against the accused.

The judge after examining the evidences and records found the son guilty and awarded the punishment under Section 302.

## One to suffer life-term for murdering wife

SIRAJGANJ, Oct 9:

A young man was awarded life-term imprisonment with fine of Tk 5,000 Sunday for killing his wife, reports UNB.

Additional District and Sessions Judge D Pramanik Sarker declared Lulu Mia, a small trader of North Faridganj village of Raiganj thana, convicted for killing his wife Shefaly Khatun on December 30, 1989.

According to prosecution story, Lulu Mia hacked his wife to death following family feud while she was sleeping at night. The Additional District and Sessions Judge announced the judgment after examining 19 witnesses.
