

Comprehensive nat'l policy for youths stressed

Speakers at a discussion emphasised formulation of a comprehensive national policy for youths to save them from social delinquency, reports UNB.

Rehabilitation programme under such policy should be taken to ensure better life for the derailed youths, they suggested while speaking at the fourth installation ceremony of the Rotaract Club of Uttara.

Neelima Ibrahim presented with Ananya Award

Dr Neelima Ibrahim was presented with the Ananya Literature Award 1403 (Bangla calendar year) at a function held in the Children's Auditorium of the National Museum on Friday, according to a press release.

Poet Shamsur Rahman was the guest of honour at the award-giving ceremony, which was presided over by Tasmima Hossain, Editor of the bi-weekly Ananya, the release added.

In her reaction on receiving the award, Neelima Ibrahim said that she was overwhelmed by it, as she is accustomed to being mocked by people and "not rewards".

The contribution of Neelima Ibrahim in Bengali literature is remarkable and her role in the democratic struggle of this country is equally laudable, observed Poet Shamsur Rahman in his speech.

157 arrested in city

Police rounded up 157 people on various charges from different parts of the city in 24 hours till 8 am yesterday, reports UNB.

Of the arrested, 23 are wanted criminals and 50 others are nabbed for their involvement in murder, dacoity, snatching, extortion and terrorism, said a DMP press release.

Better city planning stressed

Noted architect Shamsul Wares underscored the need for a better city planning consistent with our culture, heritage and geo-climatic conditions.

Wares, who is also the president of the Institute of Architects, Bangladesh (IEB), in an interview with BSS, stressed on renovation of buildings of historical importance of Dhaka city to "uphold our glorious history to the future generation".

"The process of a successful town planning is to explore and accentuate the natural potentials of the city, but in reality it has become a clumsy, uncontrolled and hazardous city due to the inconsistency of our town planners, policy makers and implementing agencies," he pointed out.

Dhaka was once a city of canals and beautiful gardens. The absence of these canals to a great extent has hampered the natural drainage system resulting in serious water-logging, currently being experienced by the city-dwellers, he said.

Wares, who is also an Associate Professor of Architecture Department of BUET, suggested shifting of the river transportation terminal from Sadarghat and creation of a cultural and recreational belt along the river front.

He urged the concerned authorities to study the feasibility of raising the low land mass of southern and eastern parts of Dhaka city by dredging the alluvial soil of Buriganga for a uniform growth of the city.

"The clumsy city we are living

in is not due to our poverty but for the lack of knowledge of different professionals, particularly our town planners, he opined.

Rahman stayed with the President for some time. Earlier, former Vice-President Justice Nurul Islam also called on the President.

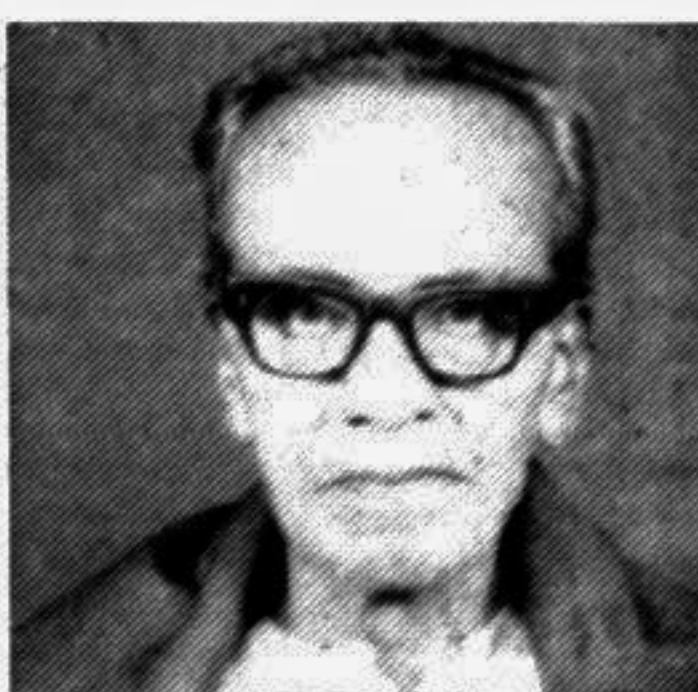
Rejoinder
