Country's judicial system needs comprehensive reforms'

State Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Abdul Matin Khasru has said an overall and comprehensive reform of the country's judicial system is needed to meet the demand of the age, reports UNB.

"Though some of our laws are adequate to meet the demand of the present democratic atmosphere, most of them are suffering from inadequacy," he said while addressing the certificate awarding ceremony of the Continued Legal Education Programme (CLEP-12) at Bar Council in the city yesterday, reports UNB.

The Council has introduced the CLEP programme to impart training to young and new entrants to the legal profession, said a PID handout.

The present government has undertaken judicial reform programme and established law commission in this regard, the State Minister said.

He said law, lawyers, judges and judicial infrastructure are the four vital components of the judicial system, essential to ensuring justice.

Applications are invited for MD (Chest Diseases) course in the Institute of Diseases of the Chest and Hospital, Mohakhali, Dhaka for the academic session commencing from January 1997 from the Medical Graduates having the following qualifications:

A. RECONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION OF MD (CHEST DISEASES) PART-1

1. Candidates shall be required to produce a certificate of MBBS degree of the University or its equivalent degree recognised by BMDC.
2. Completion of two years after obtaining graduation.
3. Three copies of recent passport size photographs should be attached with application.
4. Govt candidates should have to apply through proper channel and an advanced copy should be submitted into the Academic Section of IDCH, Mohakhali, Dhaka.
5. Original certificates are to be produced during Viva-Voce.
6. Incomplete application will be rejected.
7. Application form is available in the Academic Section of IDCH at the cost of Tk 300/- (Taka three hundred) only and last date of submission application is October 26, 1996.
8. Written examination will be held on November 09, 1996, at 10 AM at the Auditorium of IDCH, Mohakhali, Dhaka-1212.
9. It will be responsibility of the candidate to receive Admit Card on November 07, 1996 from the Academic Section of IDCH, Dhaka during office hour. No candidate will be allowed to enter in to the examination hall without admit card.
10. Candidates should not be above 45 years of age.
11. Private candidate fulfilling the pre-requisites may also apply for admission to the course mentioned above & they will have to pay tuition and admission fees as per rule.
12. No government candidates will be considered for admission into any post graduate course within 3 (three) years of a previous deputation if he or she has not been able to complete the course.
13. Candidates who have successfully completed their course during a previous deputation are not eligible to get a deputation within next 2 (two) years.
14. The candidates will have to bring "Ball Pen & Clip Board" during written examination.

B. INSTRUCTION FOR CANDIDATES HOLDING FCPS (MEDICINE)

1. Candidates holding FCPS (Medicine) may apply for admission in MD (Chest Diseases) directly in the Part-III.
2. They will need to apply in separate proforma available from Academic Section of the IDCH, on all working days on cash payment of Tk 300/- (Three hundred) only.
3. Application with 2 (two) copies of recent passport size photographs and attested copy of FCPS (Medicine) certificate must reach the Academic Section on or before October 26, 1996.
4. Original certificates must be produced at the time of the interview.
5. Candidates would not be above 45 years of age.
6. Candidates should have to apply through proper channel and an advanced copy should be submitted into this Academic Section.
7. Incomplete application will not be considered.
8. These candidates will not be required to sit for the written examination. They will be asked to appear before a separate interview board through a notification.
