## Vicenza jolt Juventus



ROME, Oct 14: Defender Massimo Beghetto, who had spent his career toiling in lower divisions until this season, ended Juventus's unbeaten Serie A record on Sunday by scoring the winner in a 2-1 victory for Vicenza report agencies.
