Services in hospital decline, clinics doing brisk business

KUSHIA, Oct 15: The number of private clinics and nursing homes having no government registration has increased in Kushia town during the last few years.
 The clinics and nursing homes are being set up in an unplanned way. Most of these clinics have no licences and those are being run by the junior doctors. Generally the senior doctors are not available. The facilities provided in the clinics are not adequate. The atmosphere of those clinics and nursing homes are not better than hotels. The patients are allegedly being charged with high bed charge and consultation fees. It is alleged that the government were being deprived of revenue from these clinics and nursing homes.

the Medical Hospital are found busy with clinic business rather than paying attention to the hospital patients. According to government rules each clinic or nursing home should have a team of MBBS doctors, three qualified nurses, one pharmacist, one midwife and a sweeper. Besides, a clinic should have a capacity of minimum 10 beds and a modern operation theatre with necessary surgical equipment. But most of these clinics violate the government rules.
 It is alleged that the doctors attending patients are irregular. It is also alleged that clinics are involved in illegal abortions in the name of Menstrual Regulation (MR) causing serious concern among the conscious people of the district.
 About 500 women die from pregnancy and abortion complications and about 25,000 women suffer from female disease every year in the district.
 A survey report conducted by a Non-Government Organization (NGO) reveals that most of the abortions are performed by the untrained nurses who generally apply traditional methods. Most of the private clinics

of the district are involved in such illegal activities on payment.
 Menstrual Regulation (MR) was introduced along with other temporary methods of birth control to check population boom.

Clash over eviction: 30 injured

BARISAL, Oct 15: At least 30 persons were injured, 7 of them seriously, in a clash at Khejurtala village under Barguna district on Monday. The clash started when the residents of the village tried to evict some destitute families from that village around 9 am.
 Police and witnesses said that residents of the village, with the help of some hired terrorists, attacked the poor families. The seven critically injured were admitted to Barguna sadar hospital.
 Police picked up 55 persons from both sides.

5 JCD activists hurt in clash with BCL

 Official sources further said eight authorised garbage removers have not been active in burning the chemical wastes, burnt oil and other garbages from the incoming vessels.

Folk culture needs patronisation

PATUAKHALI, Oct 15: The folk songs which depict the nature with all its beauty and the human life with its total pathos as well as joys intermingled in tunes have been suffering a set back due to lack of patronisation, reports UNB.
 There is no effort to protect or flourish the very rich folk culture of this region, as elsewhere in the country, which was like a realm of gold in the tradition and history of our nation.
 The folk songs, a part of folk culture, begin very clearly knitted with the life stream of

the rural people of the country are on the verge of forgottenness day by day.
 Local people said in absence of any patronisation from any quarter, the folk musics of the region are at the doorsteps wane although these songs would express the totality of rural and coastal life like rice husking, fishing, making or water cake, wood cutting, lumbering, stitching of quilt and wedding.
 They said folklore's, folk-songs and folktales are the integral part of folk culture and long tradition of simple rustic masses here.
 Nature of the coastal region is adorned with seasons here. Every season adds a new enchantment to her changing beauty. Poets, lyricists found in this sympathy of nature reflections of human joy and sorrow, woe and bliss.
 But they regretted that folk singers of the region have been leading a miserable life in the absence of patronisation and financial support.
 The local elite urged the ministry concerned to come to the aid of the poverty stricken folk singers of the region and patronise the folk songs to flourish folk culture.
