





European champions Juventus, who were beaten for the first time Sunday, will be looking to bounce back with their third successive Champions' League

victory at Rapid Vienna on Wednesday, reports Reuter. Juventus lost 2-1 at Vicenza in the Italian First Division, a result Juventus coach Marcello Lippi believes will inspire his team against the Austrians


