"We have the resources the know-how. We just need the momentum, the political support and the financial support to do it," said Speth, head of the UN Development Programme.

A highlight of the day's ceremonies was a commemorative stone presented by France for the victims of extreme poverty. saying that poverty was not inevitable. Children then placed small colourful precious stones near it in the UN garden.

Speth said that government aid had fallen 25 per cent in the last four years while private investment increased. But 80 per cent of such investment to developing nations was directed

Paris Club cuts \$ 4b debt

for Egypt
PARIS, Oct 18: The Paris Club of creditor nations approved four billion dollars in debt reduction for Egypt that was initially planned for 1994 a source close to the group said Thursday, reports AP.

The Paris Club sent a letter to Egypt Wednesday with notifi cation of the approval, which had been held up for two years, the source said on customary anonymity.

A Paris Club spokesman was not immediately available to comment.

The approval, which was expected, came several days after the International Monetary Fund approved 391 million dollars in new standby credit for Egypt to support the country's economic reforms.

Egypt and the IMF had reached a tentative agreement on Sept. 8 regarding the country's economic reforms, paving the way for the new accord.

In 1991, the Paris Club agreed to write off 50 per cent of Egypt's debt to the group, with the reduction to be phased in over three years.

The group wrote off roughly three billion dollars of Egypt's debt in May 1991 and the same amount in 1993, but suspended the planned 1994 reduction because of the lack of an IMF

standby agreement at that time. The 1994 amount represents 20 per cent of Egypt's total Paris Club debt, about four billion dollars. The debt forgiveness is expected to save Egypt 350 million dollars a year in interest

payments. Egypt foreign debt burden. before the writeoff, totalled about 32.5 billion dollars.

ADB okays \$ 45.6m

loan to Indonesia MANILA, Oct 18: The Asian Development Bank has approved two loans worth 45.6 million dollars to Indonesia for a conservation and development project designed to restore the ecosystem of the last mangrove complex on Java Island. reports AP

The project will benefit 12,000 residents of four poverty-stricken villages who rely on the Segara Anakan lagoon for their subsistence, and an additional 13,000 people from two nearby towns who fish the coastal waters, the Manilabased bank said Thursday.

The Segara Anakan is rich in fish, shrimp, crabs and other aquatic products and is also a source of mangrove wood and other wood by-products. But soil erosion induced by natural and human causes threatens to fill the lagoon in 10 years if it is not stopped.

The project will include water resource management, sedimentation control and community development, the bank

The ADB loan will cover 60 per cent of the project's total cost of 76.89 million dollars, with the Indonesian government providing the rest

One loan worth 22.8 million dollars will come from the bank's special funds. The interest-free loan will have an annual service charge of one per cent and is repayable over 35 years, including a grace period

of 10 years. The other loan for the same amount will come from the bank's ordinary capital re-sources and will be repayable over 25 years, including a grace period of five years. Interest will be computed on the bank's pool-based variable lending system.

Indonesia hopes to eradicate absolute poverty by 2004

JAKARTA, Oct 18: The government hopes to eradicate absolute poverty in Indonesia by 2004. State Minister for National Development Planning Ginanjar Kartasasmita was quoted as saying today, reports

By 2004 we hope to have alleviated absolute poverty, but not relative poverty, because the latter can never be totally mitigated." Kartasasmita was quoted as saying in the Jakarta

Absolute poverty is defined in Indonesia as those living in rural areas who earn less than 600 rupiah (26 cents) a day and those living in urban areas who earn less than 900 rupiah a day.

The estimate is based on the World Bank's power purchasing parity, a standard which defines people's wealth by what they can afford to buy.

Government figures claim the number of people living in absolute poverty dropped from 63 per cent of the population in 1970 (70 million people) to 13.7 per cent (around 25 million) in

Vietnam joins International Coffee Agency

LONDON, Oct 18: Vietnam one of the world's fastest growing coffee producers - has become the 60th member of the International Coffee Organisation, the agency announced Thursday, reports AP.

The intergovernmental body - to which 42 exporting and 18 importing countries now belong - provides a forum for discussion for member states and acts as the clearing house for statistical information on the mar-
