SATHKHIRA, Oct 30: A housewife allegedly committed suicide by taking poison recently. Kalligonj thana police sources said, Arati Rani, 22, of village Barera, under Kalligonj thana demanded a saree from her husband Shankar Kumar who failed to fulfill the demand. As a result being aggrieved she took poison and died on the spot.

Another report adds: A mother allegedly poisoned her one and a half year old daughter to death and later committed suicide at Hagachha village under Sathkhira pourashava recently. According to sadar thana police sources, Majeda Khatun, 20, wife of Surat Ali following family problems after poisoning her daughter Khuku Mia, took poison. Both the mother and her baby were taken to Sathkhira hospital where they died.

Masters final course in Chandpur Govt College demanded

CHANDPUR, Oct 30: The students of Masters of Social Science (MSS) and M Com Preliminary classes will not be able to continue their studies at Chandpur University Government College as there is no permission for MSS and M Com final year in the college.

The students have already appeared in preliminary examination. The result of the preliminary examination will be out very soon, the college sources said. National University has given permission to study only preliminary in three subjects. The subjects are: Economics, Political Science and Accountancy. Following successful results in the preliminary examinations students would have to study in the masters final in other colleges. So,

students will have to go through many problems in seeking admission in other institutions. Meanwhile, students of Chandpur Government College are demanding to give permission to open masters final year in this college. This decision will benefit them to continue their studies in this college. Moreover, National University has given permission to open honours courses in four subjects, the subjects are Economics, political science, Bengali and Accountancy.

The students studying Bengali subject have already appeared at the final year honours course. They are also in confusion where to seek admission after passing honours as there is no MSS course in Bengali at Chandpur Government College. Principal of the college Ab-

dul Khaleq told this correspondent that the college authority has already deposited necessary fees to open MSS course in Bengali subjects, however, the National University has not yet given permission to open MSS in Bengali subject. He said, Ministry of Education has already prepared necessary list of teachers in the Bengali department for masters course. Requisite teachers are also in the department, the principal added. Due to approval of the National University the Chandpur Government College authority can not admit students in MSS course this year. The Chandpur Government College authority applied to National University authority to introduce honours and MSS courses in other subjects also.

Housewife allegedly murdered for resisting rape

Workshop in Pabna Primary school teachers' accountability sought

PABNA, Oct 30: The teachers of primary schools should be brought under an effective system of accountability and primary education should be more attractive to rural children.

This was observed in a day long workshop titled: "The Present Position of Primary Education: Its Problems" and "The Annual Development and Extension Programmes of Primary Education and Improvement of its Standard."

Held in the meeting hall of the Pabna Collectorate, the workshop was inaugurated by Md Medayetul Islam, Additional District Magistrate, Pabna while Khondker Habibur Rahman, District Primary Education Officer, Pabna, was co-ordinator of the workshop.

The workshop further recommended abolition of the existing different systems of education like those in the government schools, kindergartens and maddrasahs to bring all

these institutions under one system with a modern and scientific approach, setting up of 20 per cent more primary schools during the current year, to integrate the guardians, teachers and the local government bodies in the development and supervision of the quality of education; more effective supervision of the teachers and appointment of more female teachers in the primary level, bringing down the distance between two primary schools from two kilometers to one kilometre, ensuring better communication facilities to the students in the rural areas, reduction of load of teaching courses and making the books more attractive.

The workshop also recommended introduction of paying cash money to the poor guardians of students through banks instead of supplying wheat or rice under Food for Education Programme.

SIRAJGANJ, Oct 30: Three persons were killed in separate incidents in sadar, Raiganj and Belkuchi thanas of the district yesterday, police said, reports UNB.

A handloom worker Shafi, 17, of Charnandina village in sadar died instantly when a truck ran over him in the town yesterday afternoon. Police seized the banana loaded truck but the driver managed to flee from the scene.

In another road-mishap, one Osmanuddin 65 lost his life when a speedy truck hit him on Bagra Nagarbari highway at Chandaigona village in Raiganj thana at 3:00 pm. The driver with his vehicle managed to escape.

BKB to disburse over Tk 25 cr in 10 S-W districts

JHENIDAH, Oct 30: Bangladesh Krishi Bank will disburse Tk 25.45 crore as loan among the farmers for cultivation of various crops in ten South-Western districts of the country during the current rabi season, reports UNB.

According to official sources, the amount of loan will be disbursed among the farmers of Jessore, Jhenidah, Magura, Narail, Khulna, Bagerhat, Sathkhira, Kushtia, Chuadanga and Meherpur districts.

Of the amount, Tk seven crore will be distributed for cultivation of boro paddy, Tk 22 lakh for wheat, Tk 8.51 crore for potato, Tk 8.79 crore for vegetables and Tk 51 lakh for other crops.
