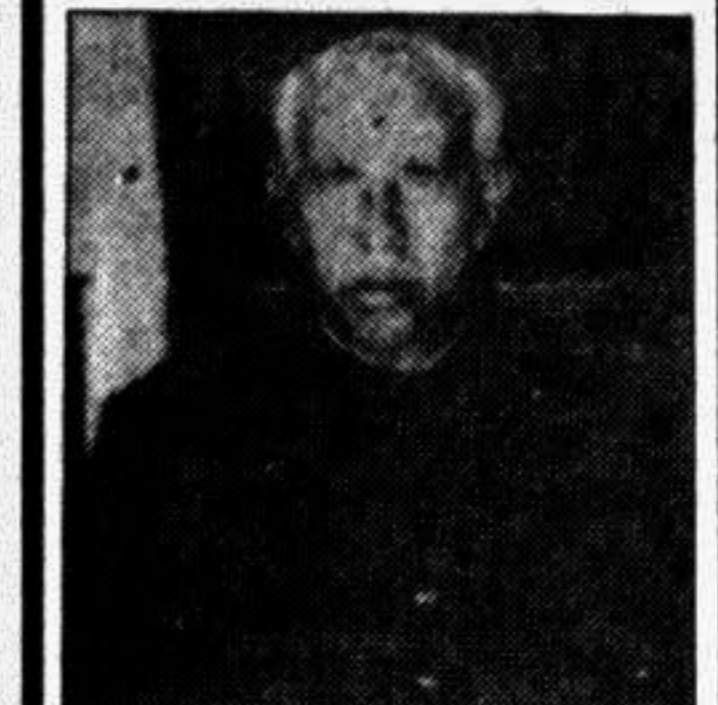
Probashi Victorians formed

106th Birth Anniversary

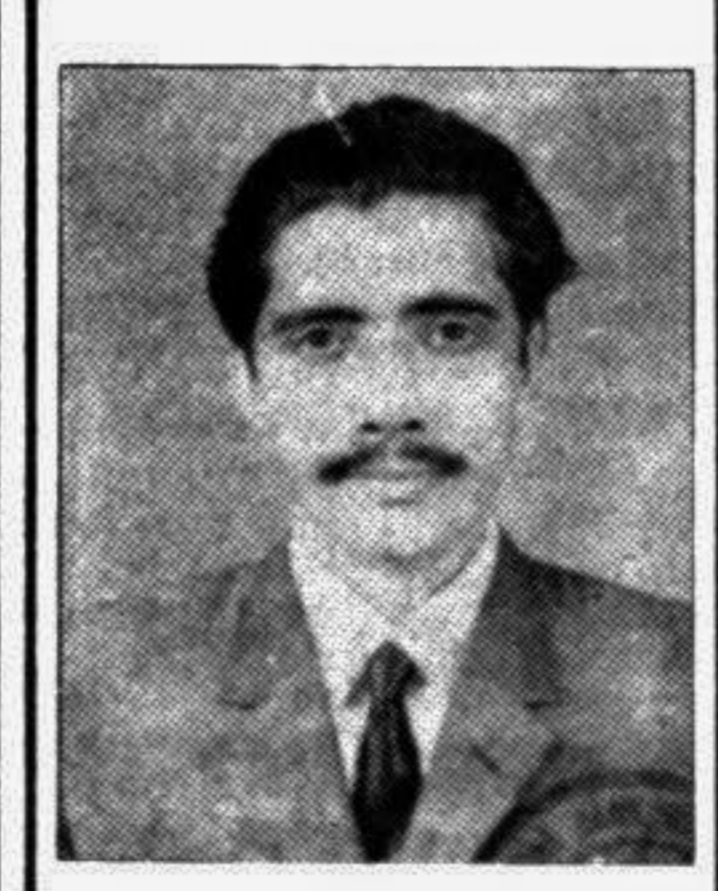

Workshop held on making marketing work

Gillian Campbell of the Glasgow Caledonian University held a workshop at the British Council on making marketing work.

Ms Campbell spoke about doing an analysis of existing customers and products and how to go about identifying new products and new markets.

Bangladeshis should be more proactive (taking initiative) rather than coactive, she said.

Her talk focused on the quality of fashion garments, developing brands and differential pricing.

Ms. Campbell's talk dealt with geographic and socio-economic marketing segmentation, product customer matrix, marketing strategies, Ansoff's market strategies matrix, strategic market segmentation and other topics dealing with marketing.

She had visits and meetings with people from different industries, companies and trade associations. She was here to find out how to go about developing a market approach in the garment industry.

Members from private sector firms, garment exporters, manufacturers academics and students participated in the seminar.

In arranging the seminar, the British Council wanted to help with education and training with fashion areas and wanted to promote British expertise.

Trained youths should disseminate technical know-how
