

Bourses experience complete bull-week

Country's two capital markets experienced continuous bullish trend last week, setting new records in all their market indicators.

The market indicators of the two bourses registered massive rise almost everyday, breaking their previous records although the circuit breaker system remained imposed to control the over fluctuation of the share prices.

As the circuit breaker system permits 10 per cent price hike of an issue in a single day trading from previous days average rate, the prices of most of the issues which enjoyed heavy demand at the floor, witnessed 10 per cent price hike on average.

The Dhaka Stock Exchange All Share Price Index jumped 792.49 points and its market capitalisation surged by Tk 5,605.13 crore due to voluminous trading recorded almost everyday during the week.

The DSE price index reached 2986.29 points on Thursday, the closing day of the week, from previous week's closing day position of 2193.80 points.

The market capitalisation of DSE surged accordingly to Tk

21,121.50 crore, from previous week's Tk 15516.37 crore.

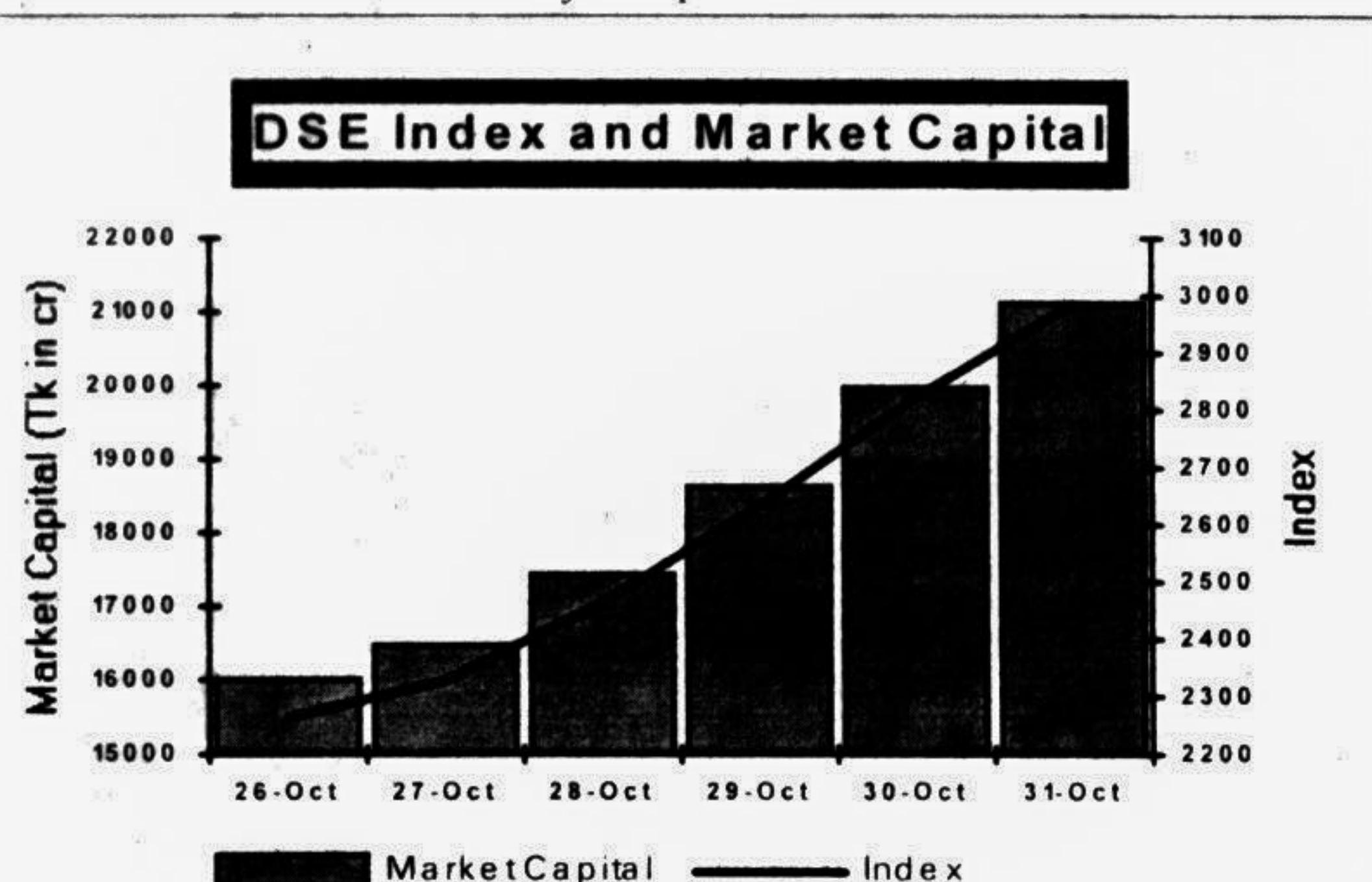
All Share Price Index and market capitalisation of Chittagong Stock Exchange (CSE) increased by 379.85 points and Tk 4,394 crore respectively during the week.

The CSE All Securities Price Index reached 1315.90 points last week from previous week's position of 936.05 points, while its market capitalisation surged to Tk 14,163.34 crore from 9768.95 crore.

At the DSE, on an average, 84 issues gained everyday and only 25 issues suffered losses out of average 113 traded issues while only three issues remained unchanged.

A total 54.52 lakh shares and debentures valued at Tk 227.38 crore changed hands. The average turnover in volume was nine lakh and in value was Tk 37.90 crore.

Most of the market indicators started going up since the beginning of the week and continued throughout the week, the trend was new because earlier upward or downward trend continued usually for two to three days.



On Thursday, the DSE witnessed the highest transaction in terms of value as Tk 49.19 crore worth of shares changed hands.

The market operators and stock brokers observed that the capital market had become expensive and gone beyond their imagination.

There was no foreign participation in the secondary market due to unexpected price hike of most of the issues, said a member of the DSE.

According to him, although the government withdrew all restrictions on foreign investment, foreigners did not respond properly mainly due to heavy speculative market.

However, some foreign companies have applied for primary shares of those companies which offered TPOs recently.

Prices of most of the issues went sky-high without any logical ground and I see a danger signal in the near future, said a high official of the DSE requesting anonymity.

He said, the market grew as much as it could and now it is high time for falling down but I don't know when this trend will start.

Nepal invites China to invest in power

KATHMANDU, Nov 1: Nepal Wednesday invited Chinese investment in the Himalayan Kingdom's hydro-electric power, tourism and textile sectors, reports Reuters.

"Nepal welcomes wholeheartedly foreign investment and joint ventures in these fields," Foreign Minister Prakash Chandra Lohani told a Nepal-China trade and investment seminar.

The seminar coincided with the first meeting of the Nepal-China non-government cooperation forum, set up six months ago to bring businesses from the two countries together.

Nepalese businessmen said China could invest in production of low-cost goods in Nepal for export to third countries.

The South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC), which groups Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, the Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka, last year adopted the South Asian Preferential Trading arrangement.

They aim to establish a free-trade area by 2005.

Chinese businessman said

they were interested in doing business with neighbouring states.

"We firmly believe that the mutual complements and increasing mutual connections among China, South Asia and Southeast Asia will help to bring about fruitful results of our cooperation," said Liu Yonghao, Director of the Private Entrepreneurs Delegation of Chinese Industry and Commerce Association.

"We will try our best to realize this target," Liu said.

Nepali officials said they want foreign investment in hydro-electric power for export primarily to neighbouring India, with which it suffers a 306.6 million dollars trade deficit.

The Himalayan Kingdom has the potential to generate up to 83,000 megawatts of hydro-electric power, which would make it one of the world's top producers.

It currently generates only 293 megawatts of electricity and only 15 per cent of its people — among the world's poorest — have access to electricity.

World oil prices go into steep decline

LONDON, Nov 1: World oil prices went into a steep decline on Thursday, finally breaking the back of a four-and-a-half month bull run which took crude markets to levels not seen for nearly six years, reports Reuters.

December futures for benchmark oil North Sea Brent blend finished down 88 cents a barrel at 22.69 US dollars a barrel.
