Eighteen factories allegedly producing fake fertilizer

JESSORE. Nov 2: As I nany as 18 factories in the district were recently found producing fake zinc sulphate chemical fertiliser.

According to trad ers a total of 40,000 metric tons of fake zinc sulphate chernical fertilizers produced from the factories have been supplied to various markets in northern. southern and south-western zones of the country for mar-

A group of chemical engineers, when contacted told this correspondent that the ingredients needed to produce this fertilizer include zinc minerals. sulphuric acid and other chemicals. Zinc minerals are most important ingredient for making the fertilizer.

No such fertilizer can be produced without this item. they informed.

Zinc mineral is only imported and not produced in the country Surprisingly, not a single factory out of 18 in the district has ever imported it so far. Still they are keeping on their production unhampered. Reports received from sou rees, say that these factories are using worst form of amo-

It is alleged that all these factories are running without supervision of any chemical engineer.

Allegations also say that not a single factory out of 18 in the district have ever obtained chemical and radiated test reports from Atomic Research Centre or anywhere in the country on their quality control.

Killers of 4 nat'l leaders must be tried: Samad Azad

Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad said vesterday that the killing of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mulibur Rahman and the four national leaders inside the jail was part of a national-international conspiracy to eliminate the Bengali nation, foil its independence and reestablish the Pakistani forces in the country. reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at a discussion, marking the observance of Jail Killing Day at the auditorium of the Engineers Institution, the Foreign Minister described the killings of four national leaders - Syed Nazrul Islam, Tajuddin Ahmed Capt (Retd) Mansur Ali and A H M Quamruzzaman — as an act of terrorism and said there could not be any worst state terrorism than the jail killings.

Giving a vivid description of the proceedings of incidents from the assassination of the Bangabandhu till the killing of the four national leaders inside the jail, the foreign minister said the Line killers must take place in the country.

Organised by the Four National Leaders Parishad, the discussion was addressed among others by Deputy Leader of the House and LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman, the Mayor of Dhaka City Corporation, Mohammad Hanif, and Parliamentary Affairs Adviser to the Prime Minister Suranjit Sen Gupta, MP.
