### Foreign scientists for research in practical fields on priority basis

Foreign scientists attending the 19th Bangladesh science conference have suggested that the scientists in underdeveloped countries should make efforts to eradicate illiteracy and superstition and build up scientific awareness among the people as well as do applied research for the overall development of the country.

Talking to The Daily Star, Japanese scientist Dr Prof Kaishuhiko Inomata said that the scientists in poor countries should do research in practical fields on priority basis by which the common people would be benefited directly.

Emphasising on cultural consciousness, Dr Abdolrasool Vatandoust, Director, Research Centre for Conservation of Cultural Heritage (RCCC), Tehran, said that the scientists should have cordial intention to create a helpful atmosphere in the country for practising science.

Some 2000 scientists from home and abroad attended the science conference held at the Jahangirnagar University campus from October 29 to 31.

Replying to a question about the poor country's strategy to promote their science and technology, Dr Inomata, professor of Chemistry at Kanazawa University, Japan said the researchers in poor countries do not get necessary sophisticated tools, equipments and substantial funds. "So these countries should improve bilateral and mutual co-operation with the developed countries and the scope of exchange of views should be widened by organising seminars and symposia with the foreign scientists."

Dr Vatandoust laid emphasis on efficient leadership and education while the Indian scientist Dr Sachinath Mitra from Jadavpur University, Calcutta stressed on the cultivation of science in mother tongue to promote science in developing countries.

Speaking about the cause of poverty in developing countries like ours, Iranian scientist Dr Vatandoust said that ill politics, different kinds of imperialism and exploitation are the sole causes of poverty in the third world countries. The wealth of these countries are being drained to a few powerful developed countries and these third world nations are being kept poor, he added.

Dr Inomata said educated and skilled manpower are the most essential factors to alleviate poverty and backwardness in the developing countries.

Asked about his bad experience and impression over Bangladesh, Dr Inomata from Japan said "I felt sorry for the beggars and the child labourers of Bangladesh. But all the problems should be treated sympathetically and as these problems are hard reality here, I would not call it bad experiences."

Both the scientists from Japan and Iran, Dr Inomata and Dr Vatandoust respectively echoed the same thing when they were asked about their impression on the level of science education and research in Bangladesh. Dr Inomata said "I have seen many competent persons from Bangladesh conducting research abroad but I felt that they were lagging behind in practical knowledge."

Dr Vatandoust said the scientists of Bangladesh have potential but they do not get essential tools and equipment for conducting research. He hoped that his country — Iran and Bangladesh can have co-operation in culture, technology and construction sectors to improve the lot of each country.

Indian scientist Dr Sachinath Mitra seemed so much impressed by the vigour, enthusiasm and interest in science education of the young generation of Bangladesh. Stressing on the inter-institutional collaboration, Dr Mitra said that the science teachers in the universities are not that much industrious and serious as the students are.
