Two convicted for raping

From Our Correspondent FARIDPUR, Nov 4: Two persons were found guilty of raping a teenage girl and both of them were sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment (RI) for five years.

The prosecution story in brief is that the convicts, Faruq Matubbar and Lal Mia of village Jagadia-Balir in Nagarkanda thana in the afternoon of May 28, 1995 called the victim Shilpee, daughter of one Jafar Matubbar of the same village into a room of Faruq Matubbar on some pleas and raped her one after another.

A case was filed with Nagarkanda thana against the convicts. The police on enquiry submitted charge sheet.

Two get 7-year RI for dacoity

From Our Correspondent PABNA, Nov 4: Two persons were sentenced to suffer seven-year rigorous imprisonment (RI) each for attempting to commit a dacoity.

Begum Laila Salma Banoo, Assistant Sessions Judge, Second Court, Pabna awarded the punishment after hearing evidences and perusing records during the trial in the case.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that at about 9 pm on December 10, 1995, a gang of armed dacoits led by Abd I Baten, of village Bharadwajpi and Amir Ali, of village Hagara went to Punduria bazar within Santhia thana and attempted to commit dacoity in the shop of one Abdul Kalam. Abdul Kalam sustained serious injury while resisting the dacoity.

On hearing hue and cry of Abdul Kalam, people from the nearby rushed to the place of occurrence and caught two of the dacoits, Abdul Baten and Amir Ali red-handed. The villagers also recovered three pipe-guns from their possession. The other members of the gang, however, managed to escape.

The two dacoits along with the pipe-guns were handed over to Santhia police.

Fish fries being caught using current nets

From Our Correspondent KISHOREGANJ, Nov 4: Fish fries are being caught indiscriminately in different parts of the district using current nets despite the government ban, report's UNB.

Local sources said a section of fishermen in sadar, Tarail, Karinganj, Bajidpur, Itna, Mitamain, Austagram, Bhairab, Hossainpur, Pakundia, Kaliab, Nikli, Kuliar Char thanas are catching fry at random from different rivers and canals.

Various fish fry including ruhi, kallu, shing, magur, boal, kalibausi, shol are being sold openly in local markets.

The government has banned the catching of fish fry under nine inches to implement its open water fish production programme.

Tk one lakh missing
