Trial of killers of
freedom fighters
demanded

Bangabandhu Youth Society held a discussion meeting at the Dhaka University TSC auditorium on Thursday on the occasion of the 7th November, terming it as the "Freedom Fighter-Soldiers Killing Day", reports UNB.

Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) President Dr ATM Zohurul Haq attended the discussion as chief guest with Youth Society President Dr Hossain Mansur in the chair.

It was addressed, among others, by Dr Mostafa Chowdhury, former DUTA secretary Dr SM Imamul Haq, DUJ president Abul Kalam Azad, Advocate Wazae Farook, Rezaul Karim Reza and Shahjahan Alam Saju.

Dr Zohurul Haq called the November 7 as "Freedom Fighter-Soldiers Killing Day" and demanded trial of the killers for the sake of establishing rule of law in the country. He also demanded trial of the killers of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and his family members on August 15, 1975 and four national leaders on November 3 in the same year.

Terming November 7, 1975 as a "black and bluish day" of the history of Bangladesh, Dr Hossain Mansur said the incident of November 7 was not a revolution.

BTV cameraman's
car stolen

A private car of a cameraman of Bangladesh Television was stolen from outside a mosque at Dhanmondi in the city yesterday, reports UNB.

The cameraman, Anwar Islam, found his Toyota Publica (Dhaka Metro-Bha 5340) missing when he came out of Dhanmondi Eidgah Mosque after offering Juma prayers at about 2 pm.

A case was filed with Dhanmondi police in this connection.

BGSF seminar
held

Shipping Minister ASIM Abdur Rob yesterday underlined the need for ensuring proper security and congenial working atmosphere in garment industries and providing minimum wages to the workers for boosting production in the sector, reports BSS.

Film director
Mamtaj Ali dead

A renowned film director Mamtaj Ali died of a heart attack yesterday at the Suhrawardy Hospital. He was 58, reports BSS.

He left behind his wife and two sons.

Mamtaj directed 15 films including the famous "Raktakta Bangla" and "Nutun Name Dako".

He was buried at his ancestral home at Savar after namaz-e-janaza at the FDC premises after Asr prayers.

Bangladesh Film Directors' Association in a statement has expressed deep shock at the death of Mamtaj and prayed for the eternal peace of the departed soul. The association conveyed deep sympathy to the members of the bereaved family.

Krishak Federation
leader dead

Veteran peasants' leader and president of Bangladesh Krishak Federation Abdus Sattar Khan died of a heart attack at a city clinic Thursday. He was 72, reports BSS.

Khan started his political career during the anti-British movement. Before partition, he was a member of the then Communist Party of India and later a leader of Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB). He took active part in the Liberation War.

Since the inception of Bangladesh Krishak Federation until his death, Khan served as its president.

He is survived by his wife, three sons and one daughter. Khan's body was taken to his ancestral home at Dashmina thana under Patuakhali for burial. Earlier, his namaz-e-janaza was held at the Baitul Mokarram Mosque after Juma prayers yesterday.

The World Bank Resident Mission (Bangladesh) invites applications for the following positions:

Operations Officer : The appointee will work with a team of highly qualified professionals in the field of Energy and Infrastructure and will be expected to perform the full range of duties with general supervision and will report directly to the Manager of the unit. Should have at least a post-graduate degree in electrical Engineering, Economics or Public Administration and a minimum of eight years directly related development experience, preferably in the field of energy. Degrees from reputed foreign universities and/or overseas work experience in the related field would be an advantage. The successful candidate will be primarily responsible for the power sector but must have the ability to work with other sectors managed by the immediate work unit, including Petroleum and Mineral resources. Will work closely with the Bank HQ counterparts in the preparation, appraisal and supervision works of the power sector portfolio.

Candidates are expected to have the abilities of strategic thinking and understand policy analysis. Should have :

- a broad understanding of development as well as the interrelationships within and between the various functional specialties;
- good understanding of country economic issues, needs and preferences;
- ability to organize and implement technical assignments under general supervision;
- strong interpersonal skills and proven ability to negotiate policy, procedural, and technical issues with Government/Executing Agency officials;
- ability to prepare strategy reports (i.e. sector strategy papers).

Audit Officer : This is a new position created under the Procurement, Disbursement and Audit Unit and reports directly to the Unit Manager. Minimum educational qualification : CA/CPA (passed) or MBA (majoring in QBA/and or finance) plus around five years of similar work experience in a reputed audit firm or in the internal audit function of a reputed organization. The successful candidate should have a proven ability to work as a member of a cross-cultural and interdisciplinary team.

Responsibilities will include, but not be limited to :

- advising Bank staff on audit and financial management related aspects of various sector projects;
- quality control of the audit reports (ensure fulfillment of audit covenants) by the executing agencies;
- participate and provide specialized inputs in project preparation, appraisal and supervision missions;
- analyze the financial management capacities, budgeting and audit mechanism of the executing agencies and provide technical assistance to the counterpart officials as and when needed, including training of project staff;
- independently carry out internal audit of the Bank's investments in the various sector projects-which includes financial as well as management process audits.

Staff Assistant : Candidates for this position should have a high school diploma (HSC, GCE or 'O' level), around five years of similar work experience in a multi-cultural working environment and will be required to successfully pass the Bank's standard secretarial tests. A diploma in secretarial science is desirable but not essential. The appointee should be highly proficient with the various Windows based computer software and formatting techniques. Typical duties include: preparing and proofing reports, taking messages, filing, handling routine queries, maintaining supervisor's schedule, making travel arrangements and inputting data into various data-based programs.

Candidates for all the above positions should have strong command over written and spoken English and should have the ability to work under pressure and in a team environment. Women are particularly encouraged to apply.
