ZIAUL KARIM: The erratic power supply almost had the kick-off of a grand show bogged. But the lights came without much of a delay and we were among the photographs of Martin Parr who is being described as 'one of the sharpest social observers of British life today.' Parr is now in the city with his mini-retrospective *Home And Abroad* and to conduct a workshop for young photographers. A while later as the bustles and dins of the inauguration died down I found Parr not quite besieged by guests and grabbed the opportunity to be close with him. But it appeared to me that he was not as lively and warm as his photographs were. It is hard to describe the feeling. Photography is so thoroughly a visual medium it resists any explanation and if an encounter with photographs of Parr's class of social nuance lasts for only half an hour the result is a wrestling with pen and groping in writing down the first impression — an entertaining *tour de force*.

Different organisations through separate statements, and holding of rallies and processions yesterday hailed the passage of the Indemnity (Repeal) Bill.

Our DU correspondent says: Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), the student wing of the ruling Awami League, hailed the repeal of the Indemnity Ordinance in the parliament on Tuesday.

BCL brought out a procession on the campus and then held a rally in front of the DUCSU building of the university. The BCL rally was addressed by Enamul Haque Shamim, Ishaque Ali Khan Panna, Bahadur Bepari and Abdul Wadud Khokon.

BSS adds: Jatiya Char Neta Parishad congratulated Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and all other members of Parliament for the passage of the Bill.

Dhaka university Teachers' Association (DUTA) hailed the passage of the Indemnity (Repeal) Act 1996.

Bangladesh Tax Lawyers' Association while congratulating Awami League, Jatiya Party and other MPs for the passage of the Bill, said that once again it was proved that Bangalee as a nation did not believe in the politics of killings.

Sangbadik Oikya Andolan greeted the Prime Minister and members of parliament for passing the Indemnity Ordinance (Repeal) Bill.

Diabetic Day today

Diabetic Day will be observed today in the country with rest of the world to create greater awareness about the danger of this dreadful disease and emphasise the need for early diagnosis and treatment, reports BSS.

The slogan of this year's observance of the day is "insulin for life" and the main programme of the day will be held in Kushtia, organisers said.

Bangladesh has 20 to 25 lakh diabetic patients — on an average two per cent of the total population, a press briefing by the Diabetic Association of Bangladesh (DAB) on the occasion today was told. The number of people afflicted with diabetic disease is on the rise in Bangladesh every year particularly in urban areas, the organisers said.

Dr Fashuddin Mahtab, a former minister and general secretary of DAB, said about 1.5 lakh to two lakh diabetic patients are treated annually at Ibrahim Memorial Diabetic Centre in the capital and at 39 of its branches located at district headquarters. The figure suggested that nearly 85 to 90 per cent of the patients are out of reach of hospital treatment.

He said under the master plan, a five-hundred bed diabetic hospital will be set up in Mirpur area of the metropolis for which the government has allotted necessary land.
