CHITTAGONG, Nov 13: Chittagong University has refixed the schedule of the examinations of different academic year due to unavoidable reasons, reports BSS.

According to a university press release, terminal examination of MA Final year students 1993 to the Department of English will now be held on December 18 instead of November 17.

IRRI-Boro farming programme in 10 S-W dists

MAGURA, Nov 13: Agriculture Extension Department (AED) has taken up a massive programme for cultivating IRRI-Boro paddy on two lakh 22 thousand and one hundred hectares of land in 10 south-western districts during current season.

The south-western districts are Magura, Jhenidah, Narail, Jessore, Khulna, Bagerhat, Satkhira, Kushtia, Chaudanga and Meherpur.

According to AED sources, the production target of IRRI-Boro paddy in the districts has been fixed at six lakh 97 thousand three hundred 55 metric tons including High Yielding Variety (HYV) and Local Variety (LV).

Sources said, Bangladesh Krishibank (BKB) will disburse Tk. 7 million for cultivation of Boro paddy in 10 south-western districts including Magura as loan.

Seeds, fertilizers, pesticides and other inputs will be supplied to IRRI-Boro cultivators to achieve the target, sources added.

Contraband worth Tk 36 lakh seized

RAJSHANBARIA, Nov 13: Police launching anti-smuggling drives recovered smuggled goods and arrested 82 suspected smugglers from different parts of the district during the last 10 months of this year. The price of the contraband goods is about Taka 36,73,969, police said.

The seizures included Indian phenesidyl bottles, wine, ganja, sugar, saree, motor spare parts and cosmetic.

According to police handout, in different raids during the last ten months of the year, they recovered 3390 bottles of phenesidyl worth about Taka 10,73,300 and arrested 39 suspected smugglers and filed 22 cases.

At the same time, police recovered 318 bottles of wine worth about Taka 95,600, arrested six persons and filed four cases.

They also recovered 301 kg of ganja worth about Taka 93,300 and arrested 13 persons and filed seven cases.
