Their controversial relationship came to light when Azharuddin walked out on his wife and two sons after his affair was made public during the World Cup earlier this year.

Azharuddin's former wife Naurren has accused the Hindu actress of stealing her husband and wrecking their eight-year marriage. The Muslim cricket star's behaviour has been widely criticised by religious leaders.

Most of India's current international side, as well as some Sri Lankan stars, are expected to attend a marriage reception at a Bombay hotel on Saturday.

### **Indian Board XI** 179 all out

BARODA. India. Nov 15: South African pace trio Fanie de Villiers, Lance Klusener and Brian McMillan combined to dismiss an Indian Board President's XI for a modest 179 on Friday, reports Reuter.

However, the Board team hit back by reducing the South Africans to 74 for three at the close on the opening day of the three-day match. the touring side's last warm-up before the first Test against India starts in Ahmedabad next Wednesday.

McMillan, who took two for 34, and Klusener with three for 38, made the inroads before De Villiers cut down the middle and lower orders to finish with five for 46.

The Board XI slumped to 103 for eight before their score was given a measure of respectability by number 10 Salil Ankola with an aggressive 63 containing six fours and four sixes.

Ankola completed a notable personal day by removing Gary Kirsten for 11 when the South Africans began their reply.

Left-arm spinner Venkatapathy Raju, a one-time regular in the Indian Test side, accounted for Andrew Hudson and captain Hansie Cronje as he produced subtle variations on a slow pitch.

### 'Rumble in Toronto' May 31 CHICAGO. Nov 15: Olympic

200m and 400m champion Michael Johnson said here Thursday that he and Canada's Donovan Bailey will meet in Toronto May 31 for a 150m showdown worth two million dollars, reports AFP.

The winner will take home the title off "fastest man in the world" in addition to the record prize money. Bailey won the 100m gold

medal in a world record time at the Atlanta Games and challenged Johnson, the first man to take double gold at the same

Johnson, who shattered the 200m world record, said both runners would receive 500,000-dollar appearance free just for competing at Skydome in a race that will be billed as "the rumble in Toronto."

## McGrath drops out

SYDNEY, Nov 15: Australia are facing a bowling crisis as they prepare for next week's first cricket Test against West Indies after paceman Glenn McGrath joined a growing list of casualties today, reports Reuter.

McGrath, Australia's newball strike bowler, was forced to pull out of a domestic four-day match starting today because of a badly-blistered callous of the left heel.

His withdrawal came only 24 hours after fellow Test paceman Damien Fleming was sidelined with a thigh muscle strain.

With concern still surrounding the fitness of leg-spinner Shane Warne, Australia are facing the prospect of fielding a severally weakened bowling attack in the Brisbane Test starting at the Gabba on November 22.




