Late Khan was a member of the then National Assembly of Pakistan.

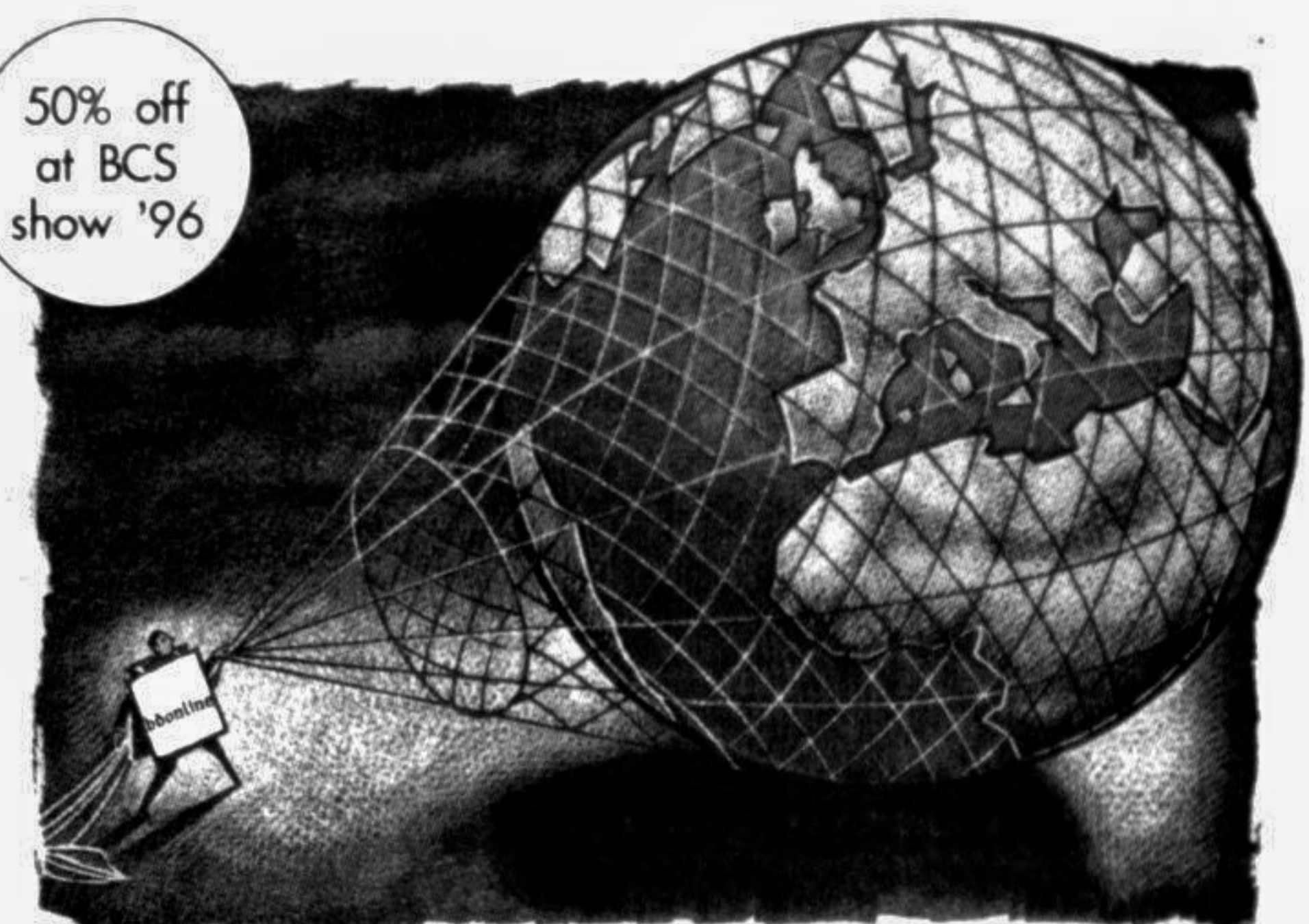

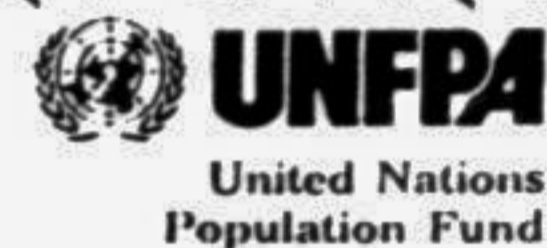
