Increasing addicts raise concern

KUSHTIA, November 17: There has been alarming rise in number of drug addicts in the district town and its adjoining areas. Social activists as well as members of the public in general have expressed concern over the matter.

The crossings at Thanapara, Katakhan and Kadamtala, Majampur Railgate Chowrasta and BDC market, Millpara, Cheuria Lalon mazar premises have turned into a haven for young drug addicts.

Guardians of these youths can not check their wards, it has been reported. The law enforcing agencies are not playing their due role in this regard.

These young drug addicts often resort to the notorious activity of toll collection from businessmen. Even youths in the rural areas are reported to have accustomed to different drugs like opium, morphine, sedative tablets, mrita sanjiban sura and alcoholic spirit. Unconfirmed reports say, the teenagers are also now prone to taking drugs causing a serious threat to society.

The youths are allegedly getting involved into various crimes day by day and gradually moving towards moral degradation, social activists said.

1500 RU Law students' fate uncertain

RAJSHAHI UNIVERSITY, Nov 17: An uncertainty looms over the educational life of about 1500 law students of 14 Law Colleges under Rajshahi University due to an unwise decision of Rajshahi University authorities.

The University authorities have decided not to take LLB previous examination of session 1994 for unsuccessful examinees of session 1993 as all the Law Colleges of Rajshahi University went under the affiliation of National University.

The Chairman of Law Department and Dean of Law Faculty have written several letters for taking examination, but in a reply to the Chairman of the Law Department, the Controller of Examinations informed that the unsuccessful examinees have the opportunity to appear in the examination under National University and for this reason no further examination will be arranged by Rajshahi University authoritative sources of the university said.

But in fact it will take at least 2 years for the examinees to appear in the LLB Previous Examination to be held under National University.

However, if Rajshahi University authorities take initiative, the examinees can easily appear in the examination with a few months, sources said.

It is to be mentioned here that about 1500 examinees took part in the LLB (previous) Examination of session 1993 held from September to December 1995 and only 17 per cent of total examinees came out successful.

2 dacoities at Palashbari

GAIBANDHA, Nov 17: Two dacoity incidents were committed at Palashbari thana in the district within two days. One motor cycle and cash money were snatched away. One person was injured and three alleged dacoits were nabbed by local police.

In one incident at 10 pm on November 12, a gang of dacoits fastened a motor cycle rider with a rope and snatched away cash Tk 33,000 including his motorbike Rangpur A-6585. The miscreants stabbed the victim with sharp weapons. On being informed Palashbari Police conducted a drive and recovered the motorbike from a market next day.

The other incident took place at 9 pm on November 13 on Amalgachi Kamorpur road under Palashbari thana in which a gang of dacoits stopped one bicycle rider Saiful Islam. Then the miscreants tried to snatch away the cycle. Then the victim raised a hue and cry. Soon the local police encountered the miscreants and caught three persons on the spot. They are Mokbul Hossain, Amjad and Dula Mia. All are notorious dacoits and they were wanted in connection with several cases.
