Reopening of Play Pen School urged

Guardians Forum of Play Pen School in the city yesterday demanded immediate reopening of the school. The school was closed abruptly by the school authorities last Thursday.

A press release of the Guardians Forum termed the closure as illegal and illogical and demanded withdrawal of a decision to raise tuition fees by 50 per cent.

The school authorities and the guardians have been in disagreement for sometime over increase in fees, six months' advance payment fees and compulsory payment of Tk 2500 to 3500 for books, and other issues.

On Nov 14, the principal abruptly closed the school as parents refrained from paying six months' fees in advance.

The forum pointed out that about two dozen — riot police were guarding the school gate.

Guardians of the students are concerned at such a move by the school authorities only a week before the final examinations Fahima Nasrin and Bahar Uddin Khelon member-secretary and convener of the Forum respectively, stated in the release.

FCPS orientation course at BIRDEM

BIRDEM Academy will start its seventh FCPS orientation course from Jan 18, 1997, says a press release.

Candidates will be selected on first come first serve basis. Last date for submission of application is Dec 22. Minimum qualification for selection is MBBS or equivalent degree recognised by the Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council.
