He said the law excluded the president and the governors of the four provinces who have constitutional protection from criminal proceedings while in office. It would also not apply to members of the judiciary on similar grounds.





From Page 1 capacities and management of the local bodies.

The study is based on an analysis of 56 pourashavas, 37 union parishads, 10 thanas comprising another 60 union parishads and interviews with over 400 people.

According to the study, the union parishads should be involved in community development, self-policing, and ensuring effective participation of people in all decisions affecting the community. Upazila should function as


the core body for implementing national development programmes, with flexibility to decide on specific activities for the Upazila.

The Upazila Council should have an elected Chair with representatives from the Union Parishad as members of the Council. All field officials should be under the direct supervision of the Chair and the Council, the study said adding that the Council members should have voting rights.

The Zila Parishad should serve as "training ground" for politicians the study said adding the election of the Zila Parishad should be based on party politics. The Zila Parishad should be charged with managing the social sector, including education. health, affirmative action programmes and equity related is-

sues. Besides, the role of the members of Parliament should be separated from the local government system, the study recommended.

The national government, having the highest level of authority and power should take on the central role of collection and distribution, it added.
