

### Angry teachers beat Durgapur TNO

**RAJSHAHI, Nov 19:** Angry teachers beat up the Thana Nirbahi Officer (TNO) of Durgapur in the district in his office Sunday noon.  
 The teachers were claiming their due allowance from the TNO for serving as Presiding Officers, Assistant Presiding Officers and Polling Officers in June 12 elections last.  
 The teachers also manhandled his office assistant Nazrul Islam and ransacked his office. They demanded removal of the TNO.  
 About 500 teachers gathered in the office of TNO Sultana Mujaddada at the call of the TNO to receive allowance for serving as Presiding Officers, Assistant Presiding Officers and Polling Officers in June 12 elections.  
 The TNO informed the teachers that they would get Tk 134 each as allowance. But the teachers claimed Tk 200 saying that the teachers got Tk 180-190 in other thanas.  
 The TNO then left the office. The teachers became angry and ransacked his office.  
 Later on the same night, Nadim Mostofa, MP, intervened and the TNO at last assured that the teacher would get Tk 200 each.

### Four held for carrying arms, contraband

**CHITTAGONG, Nov 19:** Lohagara police arrested four persons on different charges at Amirabad, about 65 kms from here Monday night, district police control room sources said Monday, reports BSS.  
 Police said, two persons along with one thousand bottles of phensidyl were held at Amirabad after conducting a raid in a shop.  
 In a separate raid, the same day, police arrested two persons and recovered from their possession a light gun, and three cartridges from Amirabad area.  
 Lohagara police registered cases against the arrested persons.

### Teestamukh ghat shifted to Balashi

**GAIBANDHA, Nov 19:** The Bangladesh Western Railway authorities have selected Balashi, a new location here for setting up of the new river port. On the occasion the Director General of Western Railway, M A Munnal visited the area to see progress of the works.  
 It has become inevitable to shift Teestamukh ghat from its present location. Fulchhari as the ferry boats could not move smoothly along the narrow, silted up channel between Fulchhari and Kalasona char. With the sharp recession in water level in the Brahmaputra basin the said only channel lost its navigability. At a few points depth of water was found only between five and six feet. As a result, ferry services between Teestamukh ghat and Bahadurabad ghat often had to be suspended.  
 With the sharp deposition of silts the said channel is now on the verge of closure threatening rail communication with the northern districts.

### Transfer of headmaster demanded

**GAIBANDHA, Nov 19:** Students of Gorya Government Primary School under Palashbari thana here restrained themselves from attending classes demanding transfer of the headmaster.  
 Sources said, guardians and students of the school filed several allegations against the headmaster with concerned thana and district education officers three months ago and sought immediate transfer of the said teacher.  
 But concerned authority is yet to take any step in this regard. Protesting the alleged carelessness of the authority the students of said school started boycotting classes since November 10.  
 Local guardians of the areas informed that they would refrain from sending their children to the school till the headmaster is removed.  
 Details about the allegation could not be ascertained till filing of the report.

### Ban on cultural activities at RU since June '92

**RAJSHAHI UNIVERSITY**  
**Nov 19:** All kinds of cultural activities have been prohibited on the campus following a clash between two rival students of gansation on June 30, 1992. Previously the University authority, Rajshahi University Central Students Union (RUCSU) and Hall Unions used to arrange cultural and literary competitions among students. At present no cultural talents can flourish due to absence of cultural activities. No cultural competition or function was held by the University Administration for the last four years.  
 The number of cultural organisations also decreased on the campus owing to absence of encouragement.  
 Moreover, the construction works of the Teachers-Student Cultural Centre (TSCC) yet to be started due to fund shortage and conflict over site selection though its foundation stone was laid by Prof. AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury, the then Education Minister on June 1991.

### BAU exams from Nov 23

**MYMENSINGH, Nov 19:** The written and practical examinations of Bangladesh Agricultural University will begin on November 23 as scheduled earlier, reports UNB.  
 The Controller of Examinations said, new dates for the examinations, suspended upto November 21, would be announced soon.

### Woman strangled to death

**FARIDPUR, Nov 19:** A young woman was violated and strangled to death by miscreants at Bhatikandi Mathurapur village in Madhukhali thana Monday, reports UNB.  
 The dead was identified as Bisham Singha Roy, 24, daughter of one Dinbandhu Singha Roy of the village.  
 Police suspected that the miscreants killed Bisham after violating her.

### Two-get life term

**JAMALPUR, Nov 19:** Three out of 11 accused, were found guilty in a murder case. Of them, two were awarded life term last week, reports UNB.  
 Another accused, Rafizuddin, was awarded two years rigorous imprisonment (RI) with fine Tk 5,000.  
 Court sources said Golap Ali and Shahidul Islam were awarded life term imprisonment with fine of Tk 5,000 for their involvement in killing Anjad Ali of village Norundi Dakshin Para in sadar thana.  
 According to prosecution, Anjad Ali was killed on March 25, 1994 following previous enmity. Victim's wife lodged a case against the 11 accused.  
 District and Sessions Judge M Shamsheer Ali announced the judgement after examining witnesses and records.

### Housewife dies after 5 hrs of operation

**JAMALPUR, Nov 19:** A young housewife died during ligation at a Maternity and Childcare Centre here Monday, reports UNB.  
 Centre sources said Nurjahan, 25, wife of one Hejal of Baluhata village in sadar thana, died at a special ligation camp five hours after the operation.  
 Family sources alleged that the death was caused by a faulty operation.  
 Fifty-three women from 15 unions of sadar thana had ligation operation at the camp conducted by Dr Masuduzzaman and Dr Tanveer Sultana on Sunday.

### School boy abducted

**SIRAJGANJ, Nov 19:** Miscreants kidnapped a bank officer's son from his residence at Soya Gabinda area in the town on Monday evening injuring seven others, reports UNB.  
 Police and family sources said, a gang of nine youths attacked the residence of Abdur Razzak, Janata Bank Manager of Barihash Branch in Tarash thana, at about 7 pm.  
 The attackers abducted his son Ayun, a class eight student of BL School, seriously beating his mother Mala Begum. Six others were also injured during the encounter.  
 The reason behind the abduction could not be known. A case was filed.

### Phensidyl seized: One arrested

**BRAHMANBARIA, Nov 19:** A total of 220 bottles of Indian Phensidyl were seized and one person was arrested from Chankula village under Kasba thana in the district on November 11 night.  
 According to Detective Branch of police, a team of DB police was patrolling at Chankula village near Mondabhab rail station under Kasba thana in the district on November 11 night while a gang of drug smugglers were passing the spot for Chittagong-bound mail train which was standing at Mondabhab rail station.  
 The police arrested one of them namely Nurul Amin of Potia village of Chittagong district and recovered 200 bottles of phensidyl from his possession.  
 At the same time, DB police recovered 200 bottles of phensidyl from the same spot. The price of the contraband phensidyl is about Taka 1,10,000, police sources said.

### Girl violated

**MAGURA, Nov 19:** A 18-year-old girl was allegedly violated at village Ashba in Magura Sadar thana recently.  
 Police sources and witnesses said, while Rekha Rani Biswas, daughter of Adhir Kumar Biswas of the village was going to neighbouring house for making chira with her aunt in the evening, she was kidnapped on the way by a gang of three. She was rescued from the field by the villagers after she had been allegedly raped by the kidnapers.  
 Adhir Kumar Biswas, father of the victim filed a case with Magura sadar thana against Arindom Aditya, Topon Mondol and Ashir Mondol of the same village regarding the incident.

### Housewife commits suicide in Sylhet

**SYLHET, Nov 19:** A young housewife allegedly committed suicide by taking poison at village Sunampur under Kotwali thana Monday.  
 Police recovered the body of Mosamath Elachi Begum, 22, mother of a child and wife of Siddique Ali and sent it to the Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College morgue for autopsy. The cause of the suicide could not be known, police said.

### One killed, two others hurt in road mishap

**GAIBANDHA, Nov 19:** One person was killed and two others sustained injuries in a road mishap near BRAC office on Gaibandha-Palashbari road here recently.  
 Two tempos collided head on near local BRAC office. The ill-fated tempos turned turtle into road side ditch in which three persons, Mohosin, 35, Babul, 30, and Shaheeda, 40, received serious injuries.  
 They were instantly removed to Gaibandha hospital but critically injured Mohosin died the next day, police said.  
 A case was filed with sadar thana.  
 Another report adds: One Shohag Sarwar, 15, a student of Class X of Thanapara under Gaibandha pourashava committed suicide by hanging himself in his bed room last week.  
 Earlier the victim was re-buked by his parents over the issue of negligence in his studies, police and family sources said.  
 An UD case was filed with sadar thana.

### Valuable timbers worth Tk 2 lakh seized

**CHITTAGONG, Nov 19:** Forest Department personnel seized 200 cft teak gamari and korai timbers from two trucks at Rajajandhala forest check point on Chittagong-Rangamati road here on Friday, an official source said Monday, reports BSS.  
 The timbers worth about Taka two lakh were allegedly extracted from the forest without valid permit.  
 Cases were filed against the persons involved in illegal extraction of timbers from the forest.  
 According to police sources, family feud was stated to be the cause of his suicide.  
 An UD case was lodged with Rajoir thana in this connection.
