## Ascertain causes of women's backwardness: Khasru

State Minister for Law and Parliamentary Affairs Abdul Matin Khasru yesterday laid emphasis on ascertaining the causes of backwardness, woes and sufferings of thousands of Bangladesh women in Pakistani jails, the State Minister hoped that the workshop will come up with suggestions as to the modalities and mechanisms to assuage the sufferings of these women.
