BFTA calls for edn policy based on consensus

Bangladesh Federation of Teachers Associations (BFTA) has called upon the government to formulate a modern, democratic, scientific and timely education policy based on consensus of all concerned, reports UNB.

The federation leaders at a press conference in the city yesterday called for considering the recommendations made by Dr. Kudrat-e-Khuda Commission, and all other reports to the present and previous governments, while formulating the policy.

BFTA secretary general Kazi Faruk Ahmed read out a written statement at the conference, held at the Jatiya Press Club. He also placed a 14-point recommendation, submitted by the federation earlier to the government.

Nat'l confce on medical education opens

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf yesterday said the government was committed to providing necessary resources for improvement of standard and quality in medical education, reports BSS.

He said medical education should be given priority as without quality doctors it is not possible to provide quality healthcare to the people. The minister was speaking as the chief guest at the inaugural session of the first Bangladesh national conference on medical education at a hotel in the city.

Organised by the National Association for Medical Education (NAME), the inaugural session of the two-day conference was also addressed by Health Secretary Muhammed Ali, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University AK Azad Chowdhury, Director General of Health Services AK Shamsuddin Siddiquey, president of the association Prof. M Muzaherul Huq, chairman of the Reception Committee Prof. Syed

Modasser Ali, and Secretary General of NAME Dr Ainun Afroza.

The health minister said that the quality of medical teaching had deteriorated alarmingly.

He said people were losing confidence in doctors and rushing to different countries for treatment, draining out hard-earned foreign currency.

Giving emphasis on preventive and community based medical education, Yusuf said the curricula followed in the medical colleges were age-old, traditional and curative-based. He suggested review of the curricula with modern approach.

Health Secretary Muhammed Ali said the 5th Health and Population Project under the 5th Five-Year Plan would give priority to ensuring quality of medical education and quality health services.

Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof. Azad Chowdhury said the growth of medical colleges could not be allowed as a business enterprise without ensuring quality of education.

Director General of Health Services Prof. Shamsuddin Siddiquey gave a brief account of the medical education system in the country and said the government was continuously trying to improve it.

He said work was in progress to announce a new medical curricula suiting to the needs of the people.

He said the government had a plan to set up a medical teachers training centre giving emphasis on community-based medical education.

Referring to the dearth of good teachers, Prof. Siddiquey said at present about 50 medical teachers were abroad for higher training. Bangladesh was self-reliant in giving post-graduate medical education, he added.
