HC issues rule nisi upon Agri Ministry

The High Court Division of the Supreme Court has issued a rule nisi upon the Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and other officials to show cause why they have prohibited a trader in Laxmipur from selling the locally patented 'Swarna' fertilizer.

Justice Mohammad Mo-jammel Haque and Justice Abdul Matin issued the rule following a petition by Dr Abdul Khaleque, the inventor of the fertilizer, on Nov 11. The rule is returnable within six weeks from the date.

The petitioner said, the Thana Krishi Officer of Laxmipur on September 3 issued a memo to one of his dealers, ordering him not to sell the fertilizer without any lawful authority.

Dr Khaleque said after eight years of research under a fellowship of the London University he invented Swarna. To enhance the soil fertility in a natural way by using a small amount of micro nutrient leaving virtually no adverse affect on the soil. He said his invention was patented on May 7, 1993.

He said after obtaining rights to market his product he had been selling the fertilizer through dealers from a plant. It had been used in a vast area of the country by farmers, whose cost benefit was huge than the conventional chemical fertilisers.

Dr Khaleque told the Star yesterday that his fertilizer is bio-degradable and environment friendly, minimising the use of pesticide. Since 1987 he had put the fertilizer field trial. Gradually the farmers became used to it.

Sandhani anniversary

Posthumous eye donation stressed

State Minister for Land Rashed Muzaffar yesterday underscored the need for turning the posthumous eye-donation campaign into a social movement to free the nation from the curse of blindness. reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at the 12th founding anniversary of Sandhani National Eye Donation Association at the National Press Club, the state minister urged all concerned to encourage the people for posthumous eye donation through vigorous media publicity.

The organisers said, Sandhani had helped 780 persons regain their sight through the transplantation of cornea. The association has also got commitment for posthumous eye-donation from 25 thousand people so far.

Presided over by president of the association, Dr Ruhul Amin Majumder, the function was addressed, among others, by Dr Manirul Islam Khan, Jahan Ara Siddiqui, Dr Abul Kalam Azad, Dr Abdullah Al Muttu Shariuddin and Prof Chowdhury Humayun Kabir.

British High Commissioner David Walker and Land Secretary Syed Margub Morshed also spoke on the occasion.
