UP elections

CEC's directive to finalise voters' list by Dec 31

Chief Election Commissioner Mohammad Abu Hena yesterday directed officials to make a final voters' list through necessary revision and printing by December 31 for holding Union Parishad elections, reports UNB.

Recasting the voters' list is necessary because of dividing the three wards of Union Parishad into nine wards, said Hena asking district election officers to complete preparations for holding UP elections in due time.

The Chief Election Commissioner said most of the union councils were elected in 1992 and their terms would end by next February-March.

He was addressing as chief guest the inaugural session of a four-day workshop on 'Union Parishad Election and Revision of Voters' List' for division and district-level election officials at the Election Training Institute.

Referring to the Election Commission measures to enhance the power of divisional and district election offices, Abu Hena said evaluation of various aspects of the implementation of ID card project was underway and a committee was going to be formed to make electoral laws, reform and system more effective.

He also called upon all officials concerned to make concerted efforts to hold the ensuing Union Parishad election in a free, fair and impartial manner.

The 25th death anniversary of noted politician Yusuf Ali Chowdhury (Mohan Miah) will be observed today, says a press release.

Different political and social organisations have taken up programmes including *Qurankhwan*, *milad mahfil*, feeding of the destitute and discussions to mark the day.

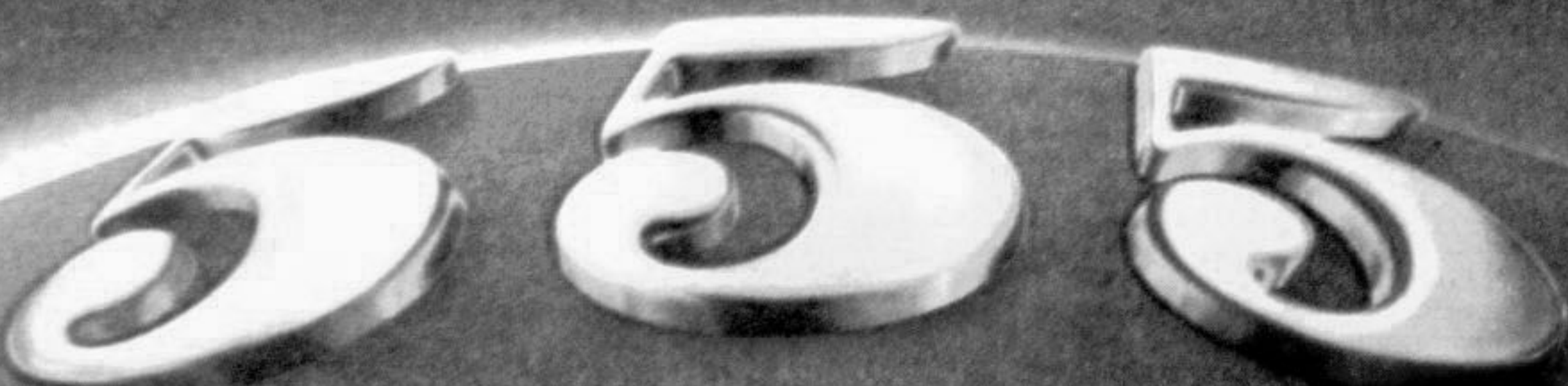
