

National Cotton farming gains popularity in Magura

MAGURA, Nov 25: Increasing number of people are showing interest in cotton cultivation in Magura district, an official of Cotton Development Board (CDB) said.

According to the CDB official, about one thousand five hundred eleven hectares of land have been brought under cotton cultivation programme in Magura district during the current season. They expected that 56 thousand maunds of cotton worth Taka five crore would be produced from this programme. About four thousand five hundred maunds of cotton seed will be collected from the farmers.

Talking to Md Sobabuddin, unit officer of Sripur it was learnt that there are four cotton unit offices in Magura district. These cotton unit offices are Sripur, Magura Sadar, Ichakhada and Satrujtipur. 635 hectares of land was brought under cotton cultivation in the village of Srikol. Sripur, Sabdalpur, Nakol, Gayeshpur, Abaipur, Bogura, and Majdia of

Sripur Cotton Unit, he added.

Another source of CDB said, 355 hectares of land was brought under cotton cultivation in the villages of Chaulia, Alokda, Srikundi, Bujruk, Srikund, Bagia, Shirjdia, Paikel, Barasia, Satyapur, Madhupur and Bagdanga under Magura sadar unit. 350 hectares of land in the villages of Binodpur, Rajapur, Satrujtipur, Jagdal, Rupati, Bailty Khali, Kamarkhali and Bagat and Sripur unit, 310 hectares of land in the villages of Ichakhada union and Ichakhada unit.

The unit officer of Sripur also informed that deltapine 90 and deltapine 92 varieties of cotton seeds are usually cultivated in Magura district. The farmers of this district cultivated seeds in their lands between late Bangla months of Asar and Bhadra. Weather was suitable during the sowing period of cotton seeds this year. As a result, they expected that the production of cotton and cotton seed would not be hampered this season.

Romjan Ali of Masalia village under Sripur cotton unit said, they have been cultivating cotton in the char area of Hanu river this year first for the time. Cotton is one of the most important cash crop in this region. About 22 maunds of cotton with seed are produced from an acre of land usually. They fetch between Tk 1000 and Tk 1200 by selling a maund of cotton and seeds. Usually they do not get profitable crop from the char areas. As a result, most of the cultivators are showing interest in cotton cultivation in their sandy char areas for taking initiative by CDB, he added.

Aziz Sheikh, a marginal farmer of the village Gayeshpur under Sripur unit told this correspondent, they can collect about 30 maunds of fuel for cooking purpose from the dried cotton plants. Many farmers in the sandy char land of Kumar, Goral and Hanu rivers are considering for cultivating cotton from the next season.

PM likely to open Pabna Sugar Mills next month

PABNA, Nov 25: The newly-constructed Pabna Sugar Mills, at Kalkapur at Ishurdi thana, in the district will be formally inaugurated early next month. The Project Manager of the Mills informed.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina would likely inaugurate the mills, according to a source.

The foundation-stone of the mill was laid in 1992 by the then prime minister Begum Khaleda Zia.

The new mills would have an annual production capacity of 16,600 tons of sugar. The daily crushing capacity of sugarcane has been estimated at 1,500 tons.

A total number of 1,075 persons will be employed when the mills go into operation. Preparations for the appointments are going on, it was informed.

The Pabna Sugar Mills authorities have also fixed the target of cultivating sugarcane on 12,000 acres of land during the current financial year. Six out of nine thanas of the district has been declared as sugarcane zone. For cultivating sugarcane in these zones, 12,000 farmers have been given loan amounting to Tk three crores for purchase of fertilisers, insecticides and other inputs. As many as 300 sugarcane growers have also been imparted training for cultivating improved variety of sugarcane.

The mills authorities have further fixed the target of producing 72 lakh tons of sugarcane in the aforesaid 12,000 acres of land in the sugarcane zones during the year 1997-98. A portion of which would be utilised for keeping seeds, producing gur (molasses) with the remaining quantity.

The mills would get a supply of nearly 40 to 42 lakh tons of sugarcane for crushing and with this, the authorities expect that the production of 12,000 metric tons of sugar would be possible during the said year.

During the year 1995-96 the farmers grew sugarcane which would now be utilised by the mills for sowing the production. At the present time, 10 lakh tons of sugarcane are standing in the field. It is being expected that at least 10,00,000 tons of sugarcane would be available for crushing during the initial stage. During the first year of operation, the production of sugar is expected to be 3,000 metric tons. Meanwhile, planting of sugarcane seeds has already started on 1,000 acres of land in the mills zone for its use in the next season for crushing purposes.

Scarcity of seeds to affect wheat farming

GAIBANDHA, Nov 25: Acute scarcity of wheat seeds has been prevailing throughout the district during this current winter crops cultivation season. As such this year production of wheat may fall short of target.

According to district agriculture department, sources, a total of 15,000 hectares of land have been brought under wheat cultivation programme in seven thanas of the district. The source said at least 1.725 metric tons of wheat seeds will be required for the success of wheat cultivation. But till to-date Bangladesh Agricultural Development Corporation (BADC) supplied only 525 metric tons of seeds among the farmers. There is no alternative arrangement for supply the remaining 1,200 tons of seeds from any sources.

So it is feared about 10,000 hectare of land will remain fallow and could not be brought under wheat cultivation programme.

Referring to acute scarcity of wheat seeds, Nur Hossain, ward commissioner of Gaibandha pourashava alleged that earlier pourashava received wheat seeds for the farmers who desire to cultivate wheat under pourashava areas as per list from government seed godown, but this year the farmers are yet to receive any seeds, from government godowns. The farmers further alleged that wheat seeds are not available in the local market. So, the prospect of wheat production in the district is almost bleak in this winter crops cultivation season.
