## Call for proper maintenance of hospital equipment

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salauddin Yusuf emphasised on proper maintenance of hospital equipment to ensure timely healthcare to the patients while inaugurating a workshop in the city yesterday. reports UNB.

Organised by the Health and Family Welfare Ministry, the three-day workshop on 'national policy on maintenance of medical equipment' began at the BIRDEM auditorium of Ibrahim Memorial Diabetic Centre in the morning.

The opening session was also addressed, among others, by ADB resident representative in Dhaka Bhanuphol Ho-rayangura.

Nearly 150 participants, including civil surgeons and directors of different hospitals, are attending the workshop.

Speaking on the occasion, the health minister regretted that in many cases, the hospital management did not give proper attention to equipment

with which doctors are supposed to diagnose diseases and treat the patients.

He said modern healthcare was increasingly becoming more and more dependent on sophisticated medical equipment, without which quality and quantity of health services could not be ensured.

Majority of the population do not get proper medicare despite government efforts to provide healthcare to the public, Yusuf said. 'Malfunctioning and non-functioning of medical equipment is one of the main reasons for this,' he added.

Commerce and Industries Minister Tofael Ahmed is suffering from disc prolapse in the spinal cord since Monday, reports BSS.

Physicians have advised full bed rest for four days. They also advised him to avoid visitors.
